

PICKLEBALL NET ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

PRIORTO USE


Inspect the netting and frame for damage or wear. Make sure the frame and net are assembled correctly and on a flat surface at least ten (10) feet away from structures and vehicles. Failure to follow these precautions could result in serious injury or damage to property.

Step 1: Assemble Base Frame


- A. Connect the Angled Tube(C) with the End Base(D)
- B. Fit the Angled Tube(C), 1 Short Support Tube(E), and 2 Long Support Poles(F)

together as shown with the push buttom locking system

C. Insert Verticle End Pole(B) into the End Base(D)




Repeat steps on opposite side. Please note the right side: fit Angled Tube(C) and 3 Long Support Poles(F) together



D. Insert the T Shaped Tube(G) into the right hole of the Center Support Base(H)




E. Insert the Long Support Pole(F) on the left side through the T Shaped Tube(G) and connect it with the Long Support Pole(F) on the right side





F. Connect the Center Support Pole(I) with the left hole on the Center Support Base(H)




Step 2: Attach the net to the base frame


A. Slide the net sleeves over the Verticle End Pole(B) on both sides and the Center Support Pole (I)

B. Adjust the velcro straps to further stretch the band to keep net from sagging and wrap the center strap around the Center Support Post(I)






- A. Blue plastic ring

- G. Yellow chalk x 3


RUKKET PICKLEBALL COURT SET-UP INSTRUCTIONS



Step 1: Begin by laying out ropes and rings flat on a court with the rings in the designated areas show on the chart

Step 2: Using the yellow chalk, trace the lines of the rope to create 1/4 of the pickleball court

Step 3: Draw a line connecting the blue and red rings




Step 4: Flip the rope and rings to the right side and trace again

Step 5: Draw a line connecting the two black rings to create an area for the net



Step 6: Repeat steps 2-5 to create the opposing side of your pickle ball court

You should have 4 equal quadrants with a space in the middle
