No assembly required. Folds up with one pull on the loop.  
Extra wide adjustable all-terrain rubber wheels.  
Supports up to 150lbs (68kg).  
Easily stores in trunks, garages, back seats, etc.  
Stands up by itself in folded position.

## CARE

Use a damp cloth to clean. Do not use chemicals.

**WARNING!** Not to be used as a children's ride wagon.

## HOW TO UNFOLD

### Step 1



On a flat and even surface with the wagon standing upright, open the hook and loop enclosure and release the webbing handles.

### Step 2



Release the handle from the clip on the frame. Use your thumb to push off from the frame while pulling the handle with your fingers.

### Step 3



Spread the frame apart until the wagon is completely unfolded. Push down on the floor of the wagon to ensure it is completely unfolded.

### Step 4



Be sure the fabric gussets are slipped over the frame on both sides.

### Step 5



Spread apart the rear wheels. Secure wheels to frame to prevent them from wandering back and forth. You will hear or feel them click. Beware of pinching.

### Added Feature

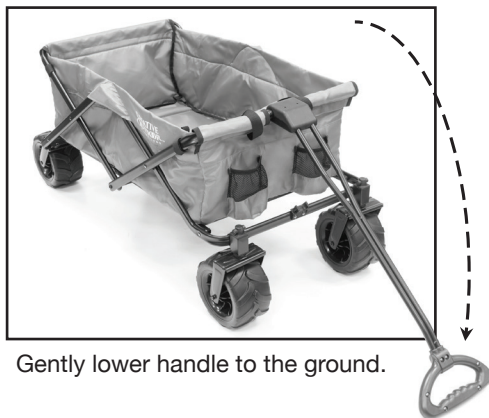


Lowering the handle all the way into the wagon enables the wagon to be transported in trucks or SUVs without unloading contents.

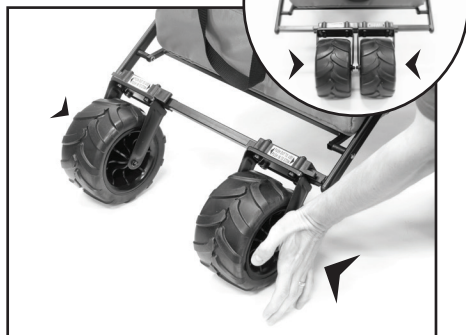
## HOW TO FOLD

### Step 1



Gently lower handle to the ground.

### Step 2



Push the rear wheels together and center on rear axle. Lightly tapping the wheel bracket with the heel of your palm can help. Beware of pinching.

### Step 3



Rotate the front swivel wheels so they are both pointing outward, if they are not already. This is necessary for the wagon to fold compactly.

### Step 4



To begin folding the wagon, pull straight up on the loop on the floor of the wagon.

### Step 5



The rear wheels should be in between the two front wheels and look like this while folding.

### Step 6



Finish folding the wagon by squeezing the frame together.

### Step 7



Secure the handle to the frame using the clip on the frame.

### Step 8



Secure the webbing handles together using the hook and loop enclosure. These handles can be used to carry or hang the wagon and prevent unfolding.

### Step 9



The wagon can now be transported or stored and is freestanding while folded.
