! IMPORTANT READING BEFORE MEASURING:

1. Use a soft tape measure (if you don't have a soft tape measure you can use a single piece of string. Cut the string to length, measure the string with a straight ruler later).
2. Ensure your horse is standing on an even surface and square. **ALWAYS** measure both sides. **ALWAYS** check your measurements twice.
3. For an accurate fit, measurements must be exact. We make allowances with our patterns for things like shrinkage etc, so you can leave this to us!

HOW TO MEASURE

MEASUREMENTS IN CENTIMETRES

Measure from the centre of the chest over the shoulder and along the horses near side in a straight line to the point where the dock (tail) starts, no longer. Do the same on the off side of the horse.

RUG LENGTH (A - B):

Start at the centre of the chest curving around the neck to the front of the wither.

NECK WIDTH (A - C):

Measure from just behind the ears down to the front of the wither

NECK LENGTH (C - D):

Start from the wither and measure down to behind the elbow or girth.

DEPTH (C - E):

Start from one point of the shoulder and measure to the other point of the shoulder.

CHEST WIDTH (F - G):

Measure around the thickest part of the face - just below the eyes around the jowl

FACE (H):

Be precise when measuring the spine (C-B) start with the front of the wither and contour the tape measure to the horse to the top of the dock.

SPINE LENGTH: (C-B):

When measuring the spine of your horse (C-B) (NEVER MEASURE THE SPINE IN A STRAIGHT LINE) place the tape measure or string 2.5 cm or 1 inch in front of the wither, contour the tape measure or string along the horse's spine as shown in the picture below.
