

Cienta shoes size guide: available sizes and measurements

Cienta children’s shoes are available in toddler and junior sizes for boys and girls, approximately aged between 2 and 10 years, and adult sizes. The table below shows the inner sole length for each Cienta shoe size (EU size). The middle column refers to our canvas shoes and the right column to our espadrilles. For greater accuracy, however, we recommend the customer follow these steps:

1. Measure the child’s foot from the back of the heel to the longest toe on the longest foot, in centimetres (cm);
2. Select type and shoe size by comparing the foot length with the inner sole length below;
3. Please allow for up to 1 cm of additional length when choosing the corresponding EU size. For example, if the child’s foot measures 13.2 cm in length choose EU size 22 (13.6 cm) which is slightly longer than the child’s foot.
