Stall DRY[®] versus BARN FRESH[®]

Stall DRY[®] is a larger granulation and is typically ideal for Horses, Sheep, Alpacas, Llamas, Goats and Companion Animals.



Barn Fresh[®] is a smaller granulation and is typically ideal for Poultry, Cattle, Avians, Bison and Swine.

What about Reptiles?

Stall DRY[®] and Barn Fresh[®] are super absorbents that have a quick drying formula. Applying to the entire habitat could absorb too much moisture and may be uncomfortable for your reptiles' skin. Do not cover the entire cage. Apply Stall DRY[®] only in corners.
