

Grandmother's Footsteps Crochet Along

Part Two - Squares B, C, D and E

Knitting



SKILL LEVEL

Intermediate

MEASUREMENTS

When complete, the blanket will measure approximately 124 x 180cm/48¾ x 70¾in.

MATERIALS

For complete blanket: 9 x 100g (200m) balls of Hayfield Bonus DK (100% acrylic) in Aran (993); 2 balls in each of Claret (841) and Cupid (944); 1 ball in each of Emerald (916), Lilac (959), Bright Purple (828), Navy (971), Primrose (957), Powder Blue (960) and Mint (956)*. Size 4mm crochet hook.

TENSION

Each square measures approximately 20 x 20cm, using 4mm hook.

ABBREVIATIONS

Ch, chain; **dc**, double crochet; **tr**, treble; **crochet st(s)**, stitch(es); **slst**, slip stitch; **chsp**, chain space.

NOTE

Yarn amounts are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate. Instructions in square brackets are worked as stated after 2nd bracket.

Squares B, C, D and E

Breaking off colours at end of every round and joining new colour to any 3chsp at corner at beginning of following round, work 1st to 8th rounds as given for square A (in Part One), using colours as follows:

For first square B only:

Mint centre then 1 round in each of Mint, Navy, Cupid, Aran, Lilac, Bright Purple and Aran, but do not break off Aran at the end of 8th round.

9th round: As 6th round of square A. Break off Aran.

For all remaining squares:

Square B with Mint centre (make 4):

Work 1 round in each of Mint, Navy, Cupid, Aran, Lilac, Aran, Bright Purple and Aran.

Square C with Primrose centre (make 12):

Work 1 round in each of Primrose, Navy, Powder Blue, Cupid, Claret, Aran, Emerald and Aran.

Square D with Aran centre (make 10):

Work 1 round in each of Aran, Mint, Navy, Lilac, Cupid, Aran, Claret and Aran.

Square E with Claret centre (make 4):

Work 1 round in each of Claret, Mint, Navy, Aran, Lilac, Aran, Cupid and Aran.

Joining squares

With Aran, following chart for placement and beginning at bottom left corner with first square B, work in diagonal lines, joining squares in 9th round thus:

9th round: Joining round: Join Aran with a slst to any corner 3chsp, 3ch (counts as 1tr), work [2tr, 3ch and 3tr] in same 3chsp, 1ch, [3tr in next 1chsp, 1ch] 7 times, 3tr in 3chsp at next corner, 1ch, place wrong sides of two squares together and with working square at front, slst into corner 3chsp on square at back (corner join made), *1ch, 3tr in same corner 3chsp on square at front, [slst in next 1chsp on square at back, 3tr in next 1chsp on square at front] to next corner 3chsp, 1ch, 3tr in corner 3chsp on square at front, 1ch, slst in corner 3chsp or in join on square at back; repeat from * once more if joining square on two sides, then complete square at front as 6th round of square A. Fasten off.
