Parsun Outboard Motor Limited Warranty

- This limited warranty applies to new Parsun outboard motors, purchased from Parsun Power Machine USA (Parsun USA) within Canada and the continental United States including Alaska and Hawaii in 2016 or after, for use in the same country of purchase.
- This limited warranty provided by Parsun USA to cover the required repairing expense of your outboard motor as a result of defects in materials or workmanship during the Period of Warranty, when properly installed, maintained and utilized in the prescribed manner, according to the Parsun outboard motor user manual.
- This warranty specifies the warranty coverage and notes your responsibilities in maintaining and operating your outboard. Please take time to read and become familiar with this warranty.

Warranty Coverage Periods

Pleasure Use - Any new Parsun outboard motor purchased and registered with the Parsun outboard distributor for pleasure use will be warranted against defects in material or workmanship for a period of three years (36 months) from the date of purchase, subject to exclusions noted herein.

Parsun peripheral equipment included with the motor, such as gauges, fuel tanks and hoses, propellers, remote control boxes, and wiring external from the motor unit, will be warranted for one year (12 months) from the date of purchase of pleasure use. Replacement parts used in warranty repairs will be warranted for the balance of the applicable warranty period.

The second or third year warranty (if applicable) shall be limited to cover the cost of parts and labor for the major components only.

Commercial Use - Any new Parsun outboard motor purchased and registered with the Parsun outboard distributor for commercial applications will be warranted for a period of one year (12 months) from the date of purchase, subject to exclusions noted herein. Commercial use is defined as any work or employment related use of the product, or any use of the product which generates income, for any part of the warranty periods, even if the product is only occasionally used for such purposes. If your boat has commercial tags, either prior to or following the date of sale, the motor will be considered in commercial use. Also, commercial use includes, but is not limited to, law enforcement, government agency, marine patrol.

Miscellaneous Sales – Parsun outboard motors which have been sold at auction or titled as salvaged, repossessed, rebuilt, junked, flood damaged, fire/smoke damaged, dismantled or other similar occurrences are NOT covered by the Parsun limited warranty.

Customer's Responsibilities

Under the terms of this limited warranty, the customer will be responsible for ensuring that the outboard motor is properly operated and maintained as specified in the applicable owner's manual and this book.

The customer shall give notice to Parsun USA of any and all apparent defects within fifteen (15) days of discovery. The customer shall make the motor available at that time for inspection and repairs at Parsun USA's place of business. The customer shall keep the outboard motor's original packing in case the outboard motor needed to be returned to Parsun USA for service.

Inspection and repair shall be conducted only by Parsun USA or the technicians authorized by Parsun USA. In certain circumstances if warranty repairs are needed, you may be asked to provide proof of purchase such as the original copy of the bill of sale. It is also your responsibility to maintain the necessary records, invoices, bills and other receipts to prove where certain repairs were performed and that all necessary maintenance work was completed using genuine Parsun parts and recommended lubricants wherever applicable. Warranty decisions may be based upon Parsun USA's review of applicable records and receipts.

Warranty Exclusions

This warranty will not cover the repair of damage if the damage is a result of misuse, abuse or neglect of the product. Examples of abuse and neglect include, but are not limited to:

- Abnormal use, Racing or competitive activity;
- Outboard altered from standard, modification of original parts,
- Careless and improper transportation, lack of proper maintenance and off-season storage as described in the Owner's Manual, improper service or mounting of motor, installation of parts or accessories that are not equivalent in design and quality to genuine Parsun parts;
- Damage caused by water entering engine cylinder(s) through exhaust system or carburetor(s); Underwater submersion or ingestion of water either through the intake or exhaust system such as, but not limited to, an improperly mounted brackets or being subjected to stormy seas or mishandling of the vessel.
- Operation of the motor at an rpm other than specified, improper propeller selection, use of fuel, lubricants, oils, and fuel/oil mixtures that are not suitable for outboard motor use and contaminated fuel;
- Damages caused by failure to follow the procedures and recommendations as contained in the Owner's Manual. The warranty becomes void if periodical maintenance is not performed;
- Damage caused by failure of any parts caused by lack of cooling water, which results from starting outboard motor out of water, foreign material blocking inlet holes, motor being mounted too high or trimmed too far out;
- Damage caused by cosmetic or paint changes due to exposure to the elements; Damage caused by growth of marine organisms on motor or motor surfaces;
- Failure or damage as result of corrosion caused by stray current or outside galvanic activity;
- Corrosion to steering system or electrical components, corrosion due to electrolysis, water born foreign chemicals, improper service or corrosion caused by damage or abuse. NB. Corrosion caused by damage or abuse.
- Normal wear and deterioration during every day, intended use of the motor.
- Accidents, such as striking submerged objects or running aground.
- Misapplication of the outboard motor to the vessel, such as under powering commercial vessels, overpowering of installing an incorrect shaft length motor.
- Abusive operation of the motor, such as operating the engine at continuous 100% throttle setting, or with insufficient warm up or insufficient cooling water supply.
- Piston seizure not caused by a manufacturing defect in either materials or workmanship

- Normal operational noises and/or normal vibrations not caused by a defect in factory materials or workmanship.
- Differences between like motors such as power, acceleration, top speed, fuel consumption, vibration or noises due to normal production variations.
- Customer applied chemical treatments such as specialized waxes, water repellent protective engine sprays and oil additives.
- Tilt lock mechanism, if damage was caused by trailering or raised auxiliary motor position.
- Use of non-Parsun parts and accessories which are directly responsible for the failure of a covered component.
- Additional labor charge to remove and reinstall non-factory installed parts or accessories in order to perform warranty repairs.
- Any other use of the motor which is unreasonable or abnormal under the circumstances.

This warranty will not cover the routine service adjustments including but not limited to: minor adjustments and tune ups, including checking, cleaning, replacing or adjusting spark plugs, ignition components, carburetors settings, filters, belts, controls and checking lubrication made in connection with normal routine services, engine and lower unit oil changes, valve and linkage adjustments, replacement of fuses, anodes, thermostats, timing belts and propellers.

This warranty will not cover the following expenses, which shall be borne by the purchaser.

- Haul-out, launching, towing or trailering, storage, telephone or rental charge of any type during warranty service;
- Removal of the motor from the boat and reinstallation;
- Transportation of the motor to and from Parsun USA;
- Removal and/or replacement of boat partitions or material because of boat design for necessary access to the product.

Normal Wear and Deterioration

Engine components which wear out at expected intervals during the regular service span of an engine do not constitute a defect, but are merely a result of the engine's normal life span. This normal wear is not covered by the warranty.

Normal maintenance parts and labor needed to maintain your Parsun outboard motor and the normal replacement of parts due to normal wear and deterioration are your responsibility. The warranty does not provide coverage for these items.

Specific Parts Excluded from Warranty

Parts replaced due to normal wear or routine maintenance such as oil, spark plugs, shear pins, propellers, hubs, gaskets, seals, cables, fuel and oil filters, brushes for the starter motor and power tilt motor, water pump parts, anodes, electric components (other than ignition system), and rubber components (such as hoses, tubes, rubber seals, fittings, and clamps) are not covered by warranty.

Specific Parts Excluded from the Second (2nd) Year of Warranty are:

- Top and bottom cowling
- Electric components other than ignition system
- Rubber components such as hoses, tubes, rubber seals, fittings, and clamps

Incidental or Consequential Damages and Expenses

This Parsun limited warranty will not apply to any consequential loss, damages, injury or expense arising out of any defect of any nature in any Parsun outboard or part thereof or in connection with the fulfillment of any obligation under this warranty. This limited warranty does NOT cover any incidental or consequential damages whether foreseeable or not, including but NOT limited to, the following:

- Shipping cost; The expense of returning the outboard for warranty repairs
- Towing charges, "Haul out" fees
- Loss of use, Inconvenience
- Lost business revenue or profits
- Alternate motor or boat rentals
- Overnight expenses, telephone calls, meal expenses, lodging expenses, etc.

Warranty Transfer Limitations

This will apply to products for pleasure use only.

- Transfer of the limited warranty from the original purchaser to a subsequent purchaser is possible by submitting a change of registration to Parsun USA within fifteen (15) days of the transfer.
- In the case of transfer, the Period of the limited Warranty is started from the date of the first purchase so that it is the balance of warranty that is transferred over to the second purchaser.
- Repairs will not be covered if the limited warranty is not transferred prior to repairs being performed.

Transfer of warranty is NOT applicable to commercial users. The commercial warranty stays with the first purchaser for one year (12 months) only.

NOTE

All incidental and/or consequential loss or damages are excluded from this limited warranty. Warranties of merchantability and fitness are excluded from this warranty. Implied warranties are limited to the life of this warranty.

Parsun USA has the right at any time to make changes to the design or specifications of any Parsun outboard motors without notice and without any obligation to make such changes on outboard engines that have been sold in the past.

OUTBOARD WARRANTY REGISTRATION

To be eligible for warranty coverage, the outboard motor purchased from Parsun USA must first be registered with Parsun USA.

Parsun USA registers an outboard motor on its purchase date. Warranty registration process for the outboard motors purchased from Parsun USA Online will be automatically completed after the shipment is delivered to the customer. An online fillable warranty registration form is also provided on the Parsun USA official website. The customer needs to complete the online warranty registration when the outboard motor is purchased from a Parsun USA local dealer.

To transfer the remainder of the applicable pleasure use limited warranty to a subsequent user, change of the outboard motor ownership must be reported to Parsun USA within a 15 days of the change date and prior to repairs being performed. An online fillable "Change of Ownership" form is provided on the Parsun USA official website.
