Answers

1. Today, you will first complete the prior knowledge section, at the top of the page, before reading the story.
2. What do you already know about ___ ? **[authors]** We call this information prior knowledge.
3. The facts or information that you provide can be simple concepts; however, they should be written in complete sentences. **[Some authors write science fiction novels.]**
4. Please say each word as you write it on the lines provided.
5. Now, read both statements out loud. Remember to use your gliding thumb.

Teaching Tips

1. The combination of simultaneously reading and writing these prior knowledge concepts will enable students to make long term connections for later recall.
2. Assist students in correcting all grammatical and / or spelling errors.



1. What do you already know about ___ ? [authors]
2. Our goal today is to learn more about this occupation / career.
3. First, we will read the story together. Be sure to glide your thumb above each word as you read.
4. Next, you will read the passage out loud, on your own.
5. As you read, it is important to form pictures / visual images in your mind. Think of it as creating your own movie. This will help you to remember the information. Be sure to use your gliding thumb.
6. Let's begin.



1. Now, it's time to complete the information learned section about ____ . [authors]
2. List 3 facts that you learned from reading the story.
3. The facts or information that you provide can be simple concepts; however, they should be accurately written in complete sentences.
4. Please say each word as you write it on the lines provided.
5. Next, read all three statements out loud. Remember to use your gliding thumb.
6. Finally, let's check to see if each statement represents information presented in the story. Is it correct? Fill in the circle that best describes your answer.

Teaching Tips

1. If students are unable to correctly recall 3 facts from the selection, they should reread the passage out loud and make necessary adjustments.
2. The process of simultaneously reading and writing information learned concepts will enable students to create long term connections for later retrieval.
3. Assist students in correcting all grammatical and / or spelling errors.



1. Let's review our recent story on ___. [authors]
2. We will start by reading the passage together.
3. Do not forget to use your gliding thumb. Let's read.
4. Now, I am going to time you as you read this story independently.
5. The goal is to see how much of the story you can read within 1 minute.
6. Do you see the vertical **red lines** throughout the story?
7. These **red lines** show up after every 25 words. [25, 50, 75, ...]
8. These lines will help you count how many words you have read during your 1-minute timing.
9. Try your best not to sacrifice quality for speed.
10. Let's start your timing now. Remember to use your gliding thumb.
11. After reading, be sure to count the number of words that you have read.
12. Write the number of words read, on the **red line**, at the top of the page.

Teaching Tips

1. If students make more than 5 errors, they should probably restart the story and strive for better accuracy.



Locating Information

1. For this activity, you will be searching for specific phrases and sentences found within the story.
2. On the story pages, you will notice **purple numbers** are provided that designate the number of lines up to that point (5, 10, 15...). If an answer is found between these numbers, you simply count forward or backward to determine the actual line number.
3. Once you locate the beginning word of the phrase or sentence, you simply record the line number on the **purple line**.
4. Accuracy in locating the information, as well as determining the correct line number, is most important. Now, let's begin.

Teaching Tips

1. Encourage students to make answer modifications as needed.



Syllabication

1. On this page, we are going to practice breaking up longer words into smaller parts. These smaller parts or chunks are called syllables.

2. Let's begin with the first word. [dedication]

3. Put dots (Sylladots) above the vowel sounds that you hear.

[d e d i c a t i o n]

4. As long as there are not two vowels together, we can place a Sylladot above each one.

5. Now, we are going to read this word together.

6. As we read it, clap each time you hear a syllable. [ded, i, ca, tion]

7. If you listen carefully, you can hear where to divide it.

8. Divide this word into syllables using a hyphen. [d e d - i - c a - t i o n]

9. When you see 2 vowels together, the Sylladot is centered above these 2 letters.

[r e a d - i n g]

10. Whenever you find 2 vowels together (vowel pair), draw a circle around the vowel pair to show that they form 1 sound together. [r e a d i n g]

11. There is 1 exception to this 2-vowel rule: the letter u is not considered a sounded vowel if it follows the letters g or q. [p e n g u i n]

12. In these instances, gu and qu are considered digraphs just like ch, sh, th, and wh.

13. Sylladots will not be placed above the letter u when you see this exception.

[p e n g u i n]

14. Now, it is time to add Sylladots and hyphens to the entire list. Remember to circle all vowel pairs.

15. Once completed, let's say and clap all 15 words out loud.



Defining Vocabulary Words

1. For this activity, you will select 5 words from the syllabication list. Write them on the **red lines** provided - 1 word per line.
2. Next, you will need to define each word, in your own words.
3. If you are unsure about a word's definition, simply go back to the story and search for context clues that can help determine its meaning.
4. Do you know what context clues are? Context clues are hints found within a sentence, paragraph, or passage that a reader can use to understand the meanings of words.
5. Remember to say each word out loud, as you write out your definitions.
6. Let's begin.

Teaching Tips

1. Students may need guidance in determining some of the definitions. Additional resources, such as a thesaurus or dictionary, might be helpful.
2. Assist students in modifying all punctuation, spelling, and / or grammar errors.



Spelling

1. The **blue lines** provided show the specific spelling pattern that we will be focusing on during this lesson.
2. All of our spelling words will consist of 3 or 4-syllable words.
3. We will begin with #1.
4. I will say the first syllable out loud.
5. You will then repeat the same syllable, as you write out the letters that form that syllable.
6. A line is provided for each letter. [r e f - _ _ - _ _]
7. We will continue this same process for the remaining syllables.
8. Finally, you will need to add Sylladots above all sounded vowels.
[r e f - e r - e n c e]
9. This same method should be used to complete the remaining words.
10. Once you have finished, please clap out the syllables as you read each word in the spelling list. [ref, er, ence]

Teaching Tips

1. Be sure to correct any spelling errors before moving on to the next word.
2. Assist students by modeling the spelling (saying / writing) process. As students say each syllable, they should simultaneously write out the letters for that syllable.
3. Sometimes there are multiple ways to create the same syllable sound. If students choose the wrong combination, discuss other spelling options.



Right / Wrong Statements

1. This activity utilizes the spelling list that you just completed on the previous page.
2. There are a total of 6 sentences; each one contains a different spelling word.
3. These words are easy to identify, because they have been bolded.
4. Let's start by reading the first sentence together.
5. Is the bold word used correctly in this sentence? If yes, simply fill in the circle next to the **green word "Right"**.
6. If the word is used incorrectly, you should fill in the circle next to the **red word "Wrong"**.
7. Now, you must refer to the remaining list of spelling words on the previous page and select the best substitute for that incorrect sentence.
8. Be sure to write this new word choice on the **red line** provided.
9. Read out loud, the final version of all 6 sentences.

Teaching Tips

1. If students are unsure of any word meanings, they should be encouraged to check a dictionary for verification.
2. It is important to provide additional support, especially when an error has occurred.
3. All errors should be discussed and corrected together.
4. There may be more than 1 correct choice for some questions.



Categories

1. Classifying words, according to topics, will improve your ability to make connections as you read.
2. Today's task is to organize all 15 words, located at the top of the page, according to designated topics. Notice that 3 words have already been placed into the unnamed category.
3. We will read the list of words together and assign each one to a specific category. Lines are provided to accommodate your written responses. Now, let's begin.
4. Once you have completed this portion, think of an appropriate topic that would include the words that have already been listed in the last section.
5. You will also need to provide another word that relates to the final topic; select your own word to complete the final category.

Teaching Tips

1. If students are unsure of any word meanings, they should be encouraged to check a dictionary for verification.
2. All errors should be discussed and corrected together.

Ordering Syllables

1. For this activity, we will be using the same 15 words listed on the categories page.
2. All words and syllables have been randomly shuffled.
3. Let's begin by reading, out loud, the syllables presented in #1. [tion, trac, sub]
4. Next, rearrange the syllables to form a word and write it on the line provided. [subtraction]
5. Continue to form words by rearranging the remaining syllables presented on the page.
6. Finally, read your list of words out loud.



1. Cut out all 20 playing cards and shuffle them well.
2. We will be playing 2 games today using these cards.

Go Fish

1. Both players (P1 and P2) receive 5 cards.
2. Any pairs found in your hand should be placed to the side.
3. The remaining 10 cards are placed in the center draw pile.
4. P1 reads a card in their hand.
5. Does P2 have this card?
Yes - P1 receives the card and places this pair to the side.
No - P2 says "Go Fish". P1 then draws a card from the pile.
6. Players take turns until all of the cards have been matched.
7. Both P1 and P2 read all of their word pairs out loud.
8. The player with the most word pairs wins.

Memory Game

1. Place all of the cards face down on a table.
2. P1 flips over 2 cards and reads them out loud.
3. Do these 2 cards match?
Yes - P1 takes both cards and places this pair to the side.
No - P1 flips both cards face down.
4. Players take turns until all of the cards have been matched.
5. Both P1 and P2 read all of their word pairs out loud.
6. The player with the most word pairs wins.
