


Shoes

you walk down the street.




You can not just buy one, I come as a pair.

I make sure your feet are not bare.






What am I?

Some are made to run.


Some are made to hike.

when you ride your bike.




Some are made for the beach.

We could go out and play with your friends.




We could stay with them till the day ends.

Scrub hard with soap till no filth can be seen.




Shoes may last a few months.

They may last up to a year.


At some point, I will break.

This is what I fear.




For a quick fix, you can use tape or glue.
