

Colorblock Blanket Wrap

#### SIZE

One Size

### **FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

Length: 50" Width: 24"

## **MATERIALS**

Premier® Yarns Allure® (70% Acrylic, 21% Polyester, 9% Alpaca; 3.5oz/100g, 252yds/230m)

- 1100-04 Antique Gold (C1) − 2 balls
- 1100-09 Pearl (C2) 2 balls
- 1100-05 Rust (C3) 2 balls
- 1100-02 Plum (C4) 2 balls

Needle: US Size 10 (6 mm) straight needles or

size needed to obtain gauge

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, crochet hook

(optional for adding fringe)

#### **GAUGE**

15 sts x 24 rows = 4" in Garter st **Save time, check your gauge.** 

### **PATTERN NOTES**

This wrap is work flat in one piece from end to end. The fringe is added once the knitting is complete.

#### **WRAP**

With C1, cast on 98 sts.

Work even in Garter st until piece meas 4" from cast-on edge, cut C1, join C2.

Work even in Garter st until C2 stripe meas 4", cut C2, join C3.

Work even in Garter st until C3 stripe meas 4", cut C3, join C4.

Work even in Garter st until C4 stripe meas 26", cut C4, join C3.

Work even in Garter st until C3 stripe meas 4", cut C3, join C2.

Work even in Garter st until C2 stripe meas 4", cut C2, join C1.

Work even in Garter st until C1 stripe meas 4", loosely bind off all sts.

### **FINISHING**

# Fringe

Cut 96 – 16" lengths of C1. Holding 2 lengths together as one, fold in half forming a loop on one end. Insert crochet hook into end of Wrap from back to front pull the looped end of fringe partially through the edge. Pass the loose ends through the loop being sure to keep ends even. Pull taut. Place each group of fringe approximately 1" apart. Repeat for other end of Wrap.

Weave in ends.
