

## Cobblestone Beanie

Level: Easy

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## SIZES

One Size, Adult

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 7-8"
Length: $8^{\prime \prime}$

## MATERIALS

Premier ${ }^{\circledR}$ Yarns Anti-Pilling Everyday ${ }^{\circledR}$ Bulky (100\% Anti-Pilling Acrylic; $3.5 \mathrm{oz} / 100 \mathrm{~g}, 87 \mathrm{yds} / 80 \mathrm{~m})$

- \#1068-01 Gold - 1 ball

Needle: US Size 13 ( 9 mm ), US Size 10.5 ( 6.5 mm ) 16" circular needle or size needed to obtain gauge
Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch marker

## GAUGE

12 sts $\times 18$ rows $=4^{\prime \prime}$ in St st Save time, check your gauge.

## PATTERN NOTES

This beanie is worked entirely in the round. The use of a stitch marker is encouraged to keep track of rounds. This pattern is written for a more snug fit, but can be made slouchy by continuing to repeat indicated rows until desired length.

## BEANIE

Using smaller needles, long tail cast on 44 sts.
Place marker and join in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts.
Rnds 1-6: *K 1, p 1; rep from * around.
Switch to larger needles.
Rnds 7-8: Knit.
Rnds 9-10: *K 1, p 1; rep from * around.

## Rnds 11-12: Knit.

Rnds 13-14: *K 1, p 1; rep from * around.
Rnds 15-16: Knit.
Rnds 17-18: *K 1, p 1; rep from * around.
Rnds 19-20: Knit.
Rnds 21-22: *K 1, p 1; rep from * around.
Rnds 23-24: Knit.
Rnds 25-26: *K 1, p 1; rep from * around. Rnds 27: Knit.
Rnds 28-29: K2tog around.

## FINISHING

Leaving your work on your needles, cut yarn leaving a long enough tail to sew shut.

Using a tapestry needle, thread yarn tail through remaining stitches on needles and remove needles.

Pull tight and fasten off.
Weave in ends.

## Abbreviations

| CO | Cast O |
| :--- | :--- |
| $\mathbf{k}$ | Knit |
| $\mathbf{p}$ | Purl |

k2tog knit 2 stitches together
rep repeat(ing)
rnd(s) round(s)
st(s) stitches
St st Stockinette stitch: knit every rnd.
