Seersucker Beanie

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SIZES

One Size, Adult

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 7-8"

Length: 8"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Anti-Pilling Everyday® Bulky (100% Anti-Pilling Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 87yds/80m)

- #1068-08 Red – 1 ball

Needle: US Size 13 (9 mm), US Size 10.5 (6.5 mm) 16" circular needle *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch marker

GAUGE

10 sts x 14 rows = 4" in St st

Save time, check your gauge.

PATTERN NOTES

This beanie is worked entirely in the round. The use of a stitch marker is encouraged to keep track of rounds.

BEANIE

Using smaller needles, long tail cast on 44 sts.

Place marker and join in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts.

Rnds 1 - 5 : *K 1, p 1; rep from * around.

Switch to larger needles.

Rnds 6-7: *K 1, p 1; rep from * around.

Rnds 8-9 : *P 1, k 3; rep from * around.

Rnds 10-11 : *K 1, p 1; rep from * around.

Rnds 12-13 : *K 2, p 1, k 1; rep from * around.

Rep rnds 6-13 twice more.

FINISHING

Rnds 1-2 : *K2tog , p2tog; rep from * around – 11 sts (after completing Rnd 2).

Leaving your work on your needles, cut yarn leaving a long enough tail to sew shut.

Using a tapestry needle, thread yarn tail through remaining stitches on needles and remove needles.

Pull tight and fasten off.

Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

CO Cast On

k Knit

p Purl

k2tog knit 2 stitches together

p2tog purl 2 stitches together

rep repeat(ing)

rnd(s) round(s)

st(s) stitches

St st Stockinette stitch: knit every rnd.
