



# Staircase Slouch

Level: Easy

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#### **SIZES**

One Size, Adult

#### **FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

Width: 7-8" Length: 8"

#### **MATERIALS**

Premier® Yarns Anti-Pilling Everyday® Bulky (100% Anti-Pilling Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 87yds/80m)

• #1068-10 Purple – 1 ball

Needle: US Size 13 (9 mm), US Size 10.5
(6.5 mm) 16" circular needle or size
needed to obtain gauge

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, stitch marker

#### **GAUGE**

10 sts x 14 rows = 4" in St st Save time, check your gauge.

### **PATTERN NOTES**

This slouch is worked entirely in the round. The use of a stitch marker is encouraged to keep track of rounds.

#### BEANIE

Using smaller needles, long tail cast on 44 sts.

Place marker and join in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts.

**Rnds 1-5 :** \*K 1, p 1; rep from \* around. Switch to larger needles.

Rnd 6: \*K 4, p 4; rep from \* around.

**Rnd 7:** P 1, \*k 4, p 4; rep from \* around to last 3 sts, k 3.

**Rnd 8:** P 2, \*k 4, p 4; rep from \* around to last 2 sts. k 2.

**Rnd 9:** P 3, \*k 4, p 4; rep from \* around to last 1 sts, k 1.

**Rnd 10:** \*P 4, k 4; rep from \* around.

**Rnd 11:** K 1, \*p 4, k 4; rep from \* around to last 3 sts, p 3.

**Rnd 12:** K 2, \*p 4, k 4; rep from \* around to last 2 sts, p 2.

**Rnd 13:** K 3, \*p 4, k 4; rep from \* around to last 1 sts, p 1.

Rnds 14-17: Rep Rnds 6-9. Rnds 18-21: Rep Rnds 10-13. Rnds 22-25: Rep Rnds 6-9. Rnds 26-29: Rep Rnds 10-13.

**Rnd 30:** \*K 4, p 4; rep from \* around. **Rnd 31:** \*K2tog, k2tog, p2tog, p2tog; rep from \* around – 22 sts.

Rnd 32: \*K2tog, p2tog; rep from \* around – 11 sts.

#### **FINISHING**

Leaving your work on your needles, cut yarn leaving a long enough tail to sew shut.

Using a tapestry needle, thread yarn tail through remaining stitches on needles and remove needles.

Pull tight and fasten off.

Weave in ends.

## **Abbreviations**

CO Cast Onk Knitp Purl

**k2tog** knit 2 stitches together **p2tog** purl 2 stitches together

rep repeat(ing)
rnd(s) round(s)
st(s) stitches

**St st** Stockinette stitch: knit every rnd.
