

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Diameter: 12"

## MATERIALS

Premier ${ }^{\circledR}$ Yarns Aspen (100\% Polyester; $60 z / 170 \mathrm{~g}, 186 \mathrm{yds} / 170 \mathrm{~m})$

- 1089-14 Green - 2 balls

Hook: US Size M/N-13 ( 9 mm ) or size needed to obtain gauge
Notions: Tapestry needle, 12" diameter Styrofoam wreath form

## GAUGE

5 sc $\times 8$ rows $=4 \prime \prime$ in Single Crochet
Save time, check your gauge.

## PATTERN NOTES

Wreath piece is crocheted flat end to end and seamed around the Styrofoam wreath form.

## STITCH GUIDE

Loop Stitch: Insert hook in next sc, yo and pull up a loop (2 loops on hook), wrap yarn around your left thumb and index finger to make a long loop, use hook to pull up yarn leaving a long loop and pull through the first loop on the hook, yo and draw through 2 loops on hook.

## WREATH

Ch 11.
Row 1 (WS): Sc in $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch and each ch across, ch 1, turn - 10 sc.
Row 2 (RS): Work Loop Stitch in $1^{\text {st }}$ sc and in each sc across - 10 loop sts.
Rep Rows 1-2 until strip measures $32^{\prime \prime}$ long. Fasten off, but do not cut yarn.
Leave a length of yarn 40" long for attaching wreath to form.

## Finishing

With tapestry needle, seam beginning and end rows of loop strip together. Fold the piece around the wreath form and whip stitch the long edges of the strip around the wreath form. Fasten off and hide tail inside the wreath. Decorate with bows or any holiday decorations of your choice.

ch chain
RS right side
rep repeat(ing)
sc single crochet
st(s) stitch(es)
WS wrong side
yo yarn over
