



Drape Front Vest

Level: Easy

SIZES

One Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length: 30"

Width: 50"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Aspen (100% Polyester;
6 oz/170 g, 186 yds/170 m)

- #1089-05 Cream – 3 balls

Needle: US Size 10.5 (6.5 mm) 32" circular
needle *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch holders or
waste yarn, stitch markers

GAUGE

10 sts x 14 rows = 4" in Garter st

Save time, check your gauge.

VEST

Cast on 100 sts.

Work in Garter st (knit every row) until piece
measure 13".

Divide Fronts and Back

Row 1: K 32 sts for Right Front, slip sts just
worked onto stitch holder or waste yarn, bind
off 6 sts, knit 24 sts for Back, bind off 6 sts,
place sts just worked onto stitch holder or
waste yarn, k 32 sts for Left Front.

Working on 32 sts for Left Front only, work in
garter st for 11". Place sts onto stitch holder or
waste yarn.

Place 24 Back sts onto needle.

Join yarn and work in garter st for 11".

Place sts on holder.

Place 32 sts for Right Front onto needle.

Join yarn and work in Garter st for 11".

Join Fronts and Back

Join yarn and knit 32 sts from holder for Right
Front, knit 24 sts from holder for Back, knit 32
sts from holder for Left Front – 88 sts.

Work in Garter st for 6". Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
