## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

$14^{\prime \prime}$ from top of Head to base of Body

## MATERIALS

Premier ${ }^{\circledR}$ Yarns Aspen (100\% Polyester; 6 oz/170 g, 186 yds/170 m)

- \#1089-11 Brown - 3 balls

Hook: US Size I-9 ( 5.5 mm ) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
Notions: Tapestry needle, removable stitch markers, 10 mm safety eyes, small amount of smooth yarn in black (like Premier Anti-Pilling Everyday)

## GAUGE

Rnds 1-4 of Head = 4" diameter. Save time; check your gauge.

## STITCH GUIDE

Magic Ring: Wrap yarn around your left middle finger twice, leaving a $6^{\prime \prime}$ tail. Insert hook under both strands and pull up a loop. Ch 1, and beg working directly into center of ring. This ring can be tightened later by pulling on the yarn tail.

## PATTERN NOTES

The pieces are worked in a spiral. Do not join at the end of rounds. Use a removable stitch marker to mark the first st of the round, and move the marker up with each subsequent round.

## BEAR

Body
Make Magic Ring.
Rnd 1: 6 sc in ring.
Rnd 2: 2sc in each sc around - 12 sc .
Rnd 3: *2sc in next sc, sc in next sc; rep from * around - 18 sc .
Rnd 4: *2sc in next sc, sc in each of next 2 sc ; rep from * around - 24 sc.
Rnd 5: *2sc in next sc, sc in each of next 3 sc ; rep from * around - 30 sc.
Rnd 6: *2sc in next sc, sc in each of next 4 sc ; rep from * around - 36 sc .
Rnd 7: *2sc in next sc, sc in each of next 5 sc ; rep from * around -42 sc .
Rnd 8: *2sc in next sc, sc in each of next 6 sc ; rep from * around -48 sc .
Rnd 9: *2sc in next sc, sc in each of next 7 sc ; rep from * around - 54 sc.
Rnd 10: *2sc in next sc, sc in each of next 8 sc ; rep from * around -60 sc .
Rnds 11-14: Ch 1, sc in each sc around.

## Shape Tummy

Rnd 15: Sc in each of the next 29 sc , [ 2 sc in next sc] twice, sc in each sc to end - 62 sc.
Rnd 16: Sc in each of the next 31 sc , [ 2 sc in next sc] twice, sc in each sc to end - 64 sc
Rnd 17: Sc in each of the next 30 sc , [sc2tog] twice, sc in each sc around - 62 sc .
Rnd 18: Sc in each of the next 29 sc , [sc2tog] twice, sc in each sc around - 60 sc.

## Shape Body

Rnd 19: *Sc2tog, sc in next 8 sc; rep from * around 54 sc.
Rnd 20: *Sc2tog, sc in next 7 sc ; rep from * around 48 sc.
Rnd 21: *Sc2tog, sc in next 6 sc ; rep from * around 42 sc.
Rnd 22: *Sc2tog, sc in next 5 sc; rep from * around 36 sc.
Rnds 23-25: Sc in each sc around.
Rnd 26: *Sc2tog, sc in next 4 sc ; rep from * around 30 sc .
Rnds 27-29: Sc in each sc around.
Rnd 30: *Sc2tog, sc in next 3 sc; rep from * around 24 sc
Fasten off.
Stuff Body and set aside.

## Nose

Make Magic Ring
Rnd 1: 6sc in ring - 6 sc.
Rnd 2: [Sc, 3sc in next sc, sc in next sc] twice - 10 sc .
Rnd 3: [Sc in next 2 sc , 3sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc ] twice - 14 sc.
Rnd 4: [Sc in next $3 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc , sc in next 3 sc ] twice - 18 sc.
Fasten off. Set aside.

## Head

Make Magic Ring.
Rnds 1-8: Work Rnds 1-8 of Body - 48 sc .
Rnds 9-14: Sc in each sc around.
Rnd 15: *Sc2tog, sc in each of next 6 sc; rep from * around - 42 sc .
Rnd 16: *Sc2tog, sc in each of next 5 sc; rep from * around - 36 sc.
Rnd 17: *Sc2tog, sc in each of next 4 sc; rep from * around - 30 sc.
Sew nose to head leaving an opening on one side of Nose for stuffing. Stuff nose. Sew closed.
Attach safety eyes or use smooth yarn and tapestry needle to embroider eyes above nose (using photo as a guide).
Stuff Head and continue working as follows:
Rnd 18: *Sc2tog, sc in each of next 3 sc; rep from * around - 24 sc .
Rnd 19: *Sc2tog, sc in each of next 2 sc ; rep from * around - 18 sc .

Rnd 20: *Sc2tog, sc in next sc; rep from * around 12 sc.

Rnd 21: *Sc2tog; rep from * around - 6 sc.
Place yarn on tapestry needle, thread through each of the 6 remaining sc. Draw up to close. Secure end.

Ears and Tail (make 6)
Ch 6.
Row 1: Sc in $2^{\text {nd }} \mathrm{sc}$ from hook, sc in next $4 \mathrm{sc}-5 \mathrm{sc}$.
Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc.
Row 3: Ch 1, sc in next sc, hdc in next sc, dc in next sc, hdc in next sc, sc in next sc.
Row 4: Ch 1, sc2tog over next 2 sts, hdc in dc, sc2tog over next 2 sts -3 sts.
Row 5: Ch 1, sc3tog. Fasten off.

Arms (make 2)
Make Magic Ring
Rnds 1-4: Work Rows 1-4 of Body - 24 sc.
Rnds 5-8: Sc in each sc around.
Rnd 9: *Sc2tog, sc in next 2 sc ; rep from * around 18 sc.
Rnds 10-13: Sc in each sc around.
Rnd 14: *Sc2tog, sc in next sc; rep from * around 12 sc.
Rnds 15-18: Sc in each sc around.
Fasten off.
Stuff Arms.

## Legs (make 2)

Make Magic Ring.
Rnds 1-5: Work Rnds 1-5 of Body - 30 sc.
Rnds 6-9: Sc in each sc around.

## Shape Toes

Rnd 10: Sc in each of next 13 sc , [sc2tog] twice, sc in each sc to end -28 sc .
Rnd 11: Sc in each of the next 12 sc , [sc2tog] twice, sc in each sc to end - 26 sc.
Rnd 12: Sc in each of the next 11 sc , [sc2tog] twice, sc in each sc to end - 24 sc.

## Shape Legs

Rnds 13-15: Sc in each sc around.
Rnd 16: *Sc2tog, sc in next 2 sc; rep from * around 18 sc.
Rnds 17-19: Sc in each sc around.
Fasten off.
Stuff Legs.

## FINISHING

Note: Use photo as a guide for placement throughout.
Sew 2 pieces together for Ear. Repeat for $2^{\text {nd }}$ ear.
Sew Ears to Head.
Sew 2 pieces together, leaving an opening
approximately $1 / 4$ of the circumference for stuffing. Stuff tail. Sew tail to Body.
Weave in ends.
