

Aubergine Ripple Throw

Level: Intermediate



Finished Size

45" x 66"

MATERIALS

Deborah Norville Collection™ Everyday® Soft Worsted by Premier® Yarns (100% anti-pilling acrylic; 113g/203 yds)

- 100-19 Navy (A): 5 balls
- 100-10 Aubergine (B): 3 balls
- 100-33 Violet (C): 3 balls
- 100-20 Orchid (D): 3 balls
- 100-01 Snow White (E): 3 balls

Needles: US size I-9 (5.5mm) hook or size needed

to obtain gauge
Notions: Yarn needle

GAUGE

1 pat rep = 3½" wide 5.5 rows = 4" measured at point of ripple Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

Stripe Pattern: *4 rows A, 2 rows B, 2 rows C, 2 rows D, 2 rows E; rep from * ending with 2 rows of A.

PATTERN NOTES

To adjust width of throw add or subtract multiples of 20 ch to beg-ch.

THROW

With A, ch 260.

Row 1 (RS): Dc in 4th ch from hk, * ch 3, sk 3 ch, 2 dc in next ch, ch 3, sk 3 ch, (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in next ch, (ch 3, sk 3 ch, 2 dc in next ch) twice, ** sk 3 ch, 2 dc in next ch; rep from * 12 more times, ending last rep at **, turn.

Row 2: Ch 3, * (2 dc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3) twice, (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in next ch-3 sp, (ch 3, 2 dc in next ch-3 sp) twice; rep from * across, turn.

Rows 3-4: Ch 3, *(2 dc in the center of the 2-dc shell below the next ch-3 sp, ch 3) twice, (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in next ch-3 sp, (ch 3, 2 dc in the center of the 2-dc shell below the next ch-3 sp) twice; rep from * across, turn.

Continue to rep Rows 3-4 until the blanket measures approx. 66", following stripe patt, ending with 2 rows of A.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

beg begin(ning) ch chain

double crochet dc

pattern patt repeat(ing) rep RS right side skip sk sp space stitch(es) st(s) wrong side WS
