

Honeycomb Cowl

SIZE

One Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 29¾"

Height: 15"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Anti-Pilling Bamboo Chunky® (80% Anti-Pilling Acrylic, 20% Rayon from Bamboo; 3.5oz/100g, 131yds/120m)

• 1085-01 Mochi – 2 balls

Needle: US Size 10½ (6.5 mm) and US Size 10 (6 mm) 24" needles *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch marker, cable needle

GAUGE

14 sts x 18 rnds = 4" in pattern stitch with larger needle

Save time, check your gauge.

Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Knit and purl stitches
- Knitting in the round
- Yo increases
- Ssk and k2tog decreases
- Cable knitting

STITCH GUIDE

2x2 Rib (multiple of 4 sts)

Rnd 1: *K2, p2; rep from * to end. Rep Rnd 1 for patt. **Honeycomb Pattern** (multiple of 8 sts, pattern is charted on next page)

Rnd 1: *K1, **1/2 RC**, k1, **1/2 LC**; rep from * to end.

Even Rnds 2-12: Knit.

Rnd 3: *Yo, k2tog, k6; rep from * to end. Rnd 5: *Yo, k6, ssk; rep from * to end. Rnd 7: *K1, 1/2 LC, k1, 1/2 RC; rep from * to end.

Rnd 9: *K4, yo, k2tog, k2; rep from * to end. Rnd 11: *K3, ssk, yo, k3; rep from * to end. Rep Rnds 1-12 for patt.

2/1RC (2/1 Right Cross): Slip 1 st onto cable needle and hold in back, k2, k1 from cable needle.

2/1LC (2/1 Left Cross): Slip 2 sts onto cable needle and hold in front, k1, k2 from cable needle.

PATTERN NOTES

The Cowl is worked from the bottom up in the round.

COWL

With smaller needle, cast on 104 sts, pm and join for working in the rnd careful not to twist sts. Work even in **2x2 Rib** until piece meas 2". Switch to larger needle and work even in **Honeycomb Pattern** until piece meas 13" from cast-on edge or to desired height, less 2". Switch to smaller needle and work even in **2x2 Rib** for 2". Loosely bind off all sts in rib.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

k2tog knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)

meas measures

p purl
patt pattern

pm place marker

rep repeat(ing)

ssk slip slip knit (1 st dec'd)
