Level: Intermediate

SIZES

XS (S, M, L, XL, 1X, 2X) Shown in Small Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Bust: 33¼ (40, 45¼, 46¾, 52, 57¼, 62¼)" **Length:** 24½ (26, 27½, 28, 29½, 30)"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Anti-Pilling Bamboo Chunky (80% Anti-Pilling Acrylic, 20% Rayon from Bamboo; 3.5oz/100g, 131yds/120m)

• #1085-02 Mushroom – 7 (7, 8, 9, 10, 11,11) balls

Needle: US Size 10 (6 mm) 32" circular needle, US Size 10.5 (6.5 mm) 24" circular needle *or*

size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch holder or

waste yarn

GAUGE

14 sts x 18 rows = 4" in St st with larger needles **Save time, check your gauge.**

STITCH GUIDE

Pouble Rib Pattern (multiple of 6 sts) **Row 1 (RS):** *K3, P3; rep from * to end. **Row 2:** K1, P1; rep from * to end.

Rep Rows 1-2 for patt.

CARDIGAN

Back

With smaller needles, cast on 60 (72, 78, 84, 90, 96, 102) sts. Work in **Double Rib Pattern** for 4". Change to larger needle and work in St st (knit on RS rows; purl on WS rows) until piece measures 16 (16½, 17, 17, 17½, 17½, 17½)" from cast-on.

Place marker to indicate armhole placement. Work even in pattern until armhole measures 6% (7%, 9, 9%, 10, 10%, 10%)", ending with a WS row.

Shape Neck

Next Row (RS): K21 (27, 28, 30, 32, 35, 37) sts and place on holder or waste yarn; join a second ball of yarn and bind off the center 18 (18, 22, 24, 26, 26, 28) sts, knit to end – 21 (27, 28, 30, 32, 35, 37) sts for each shoulder.

Left Shoulder Next Row: Purl.

Dec Row (RS): K1, ssk, knit to end -1 st

decreased.

Next Row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows, once more, then work Dec Row one more time – 18 (24, 25, 27, 29, 32, 34)

sts.

Work even in St st until armhole measures $8\frac{1}{2}$ (9\frac{1}{2}, 10\frac{1}{2}, 11, 11\frac{1}{2}, 12\frac{1}{2})", ending with a RS row.

Bind off 9 (11, 12, 13, 14, 16, 17) sts, purl to end.

Next Row: Knit. Bind off remaining sts.

Right Shoulder

With RS facing, begin at neck edge and work as follows:

Dec Row (RS): Knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 - 1 st

dec'd.

Next Row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows, 3 more times – 18 (24, 25, 27, 29, 32, 34) sts.

Work even in St st until armhole measures 8½ (9½, 10½, 11, 11½, 12, 12½)", ending with a WS row.

Shape Shoulders

Bind off 9 (11, 12, 13, 14, 16, 17) sts, knit to end.

Next Row: Purl.

Bind off remaining sts.

Left Front

With smaller needles, cast on 24 (30, 36, 36, 42, 48, 54) sts. Work in **Double Rib Pattern** until piece measures 4". Change to larger needles and work in St st until piece measures 16 (16½, 17, 17, 17½, 17½, 17½)" from cast-on ending with WS row. Place marker to indicate armhole placement.

Neck Shaping

Dec Row (RS): Knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 – 1 st dec'd. **Next Row:** Purl.

Rep **Dec Row** every 6th (8th, 6th, 4th, 4th, 4th) row, 5 (2, 1, 6, 12, 10, 7) more time(s), then every -- (6th, 4th, 4th, --, 2nd, 2nd) row, -- (3, 9, 2, --, 5, 12) times – 18 (24, 25, 27, 29, 32, 34) sts.

Work even in St st until armhole measures 8% (9%, 10%, 11, 11%, 12, 12%)" ending with a WS row.

Shape Shoulders

Bind off 9 (11, 12, 13, 14, 16, 17) sts, knit to end.

Next Row: Purl.

Bind off remaining sts.

Right Front

Work as for Left Front to Neck Shaping.

Dec Row (RS): K1, ssk, knit to end – 1 st dec'd. **Next Row:** Purl.

Rep **Dec Row** every 6th (8th, 6th, 6th, 4th, 4th, 4th) row, 5 (2, 1, 6, 12, 10, 7) more time(s), then every -- (6th, 4th, 4th, --, 2nd, 2nd) row, -- (3, 9, 2, --, 5, 12) times – 18 (24, 25, 27, 29, 32, 34) sts.

Work even in St st until armhole measures 8½ (9½, 10½, 11, 11½, 12, 12½)" ending with a RS row.

Shape Shoulders

Bind off 9 (11, 12, 13, 14, 16, 17) sts, purl to end. **Next Row:** Knit.

Bind off remaining sts.

Sleeves

With smaller needles, cast on 30 (30, 30, 36, 36, 36, 42) sts. Work in Double Rib Pattern for 4" ending with a WS row.

Inc Row (RS): Change to larger needles, K1, m1, knit to last st, m1, k1 - 2 sts inc'd.

Working in St st, rep Inc Row every 4th row, 13 (12, 8, 11, 8, 8, 10) more times, then every 2nd row, 2 (6, 14, 9, 15, 16, 12) times – 62 (68, 76, 78, 84, 86, 88) sts. Work even in St st until sleeve measures $17\frac{1}{4}$ (18, $18\frac{1}{4}$, $18\frac{1}{4}$, $18\frac{1}{4}$, $19\frac{1}{4}$)" from cast-on. Bind off.

FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams. Sew in sleeves between markers. Sew side and sleeve seams.

Front Bands/Collar

With RS facing, using smaller circular needle, beginning at lower Right Front edge and ending as lower Left Front edge, pick up and knit approximately 2 sts for every 3 rows along vertical edges, 3 sts for every 4 rows along neck edge and 1 st in each bound off st of back neck, making sure to pick up a multiple of 6 stitches so that rib pattern will work. Work in Double Rib Pattern for 4". Bind off loosely in pattern. Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

inc('d) increase(d)

k knit

k2tog knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)

m1 make 1 (1 st inc'd)

p purlpatt patternrep repeat(ing)RS right side

ssk slip slip knit (1 st dec'd)

st(s) stitch(es)

St st Stockinette stitch: knit on RS rows,

purl on WS rows.

WS wrong side
