

# Open Fan Stitch Cowl

## **FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

Circumference: 60"

Width: 7"

#### **MATERIALS**

Premier® Yarns Anti-Pilling® Bamboo Chunky (80% Anti-pilling Acrylic, 20% Rayon from Bamboo; 3.5oz/100g, 131yds/120m)

• 1085-18 Kiwi – 3 balls

Hook: US Size K/10 (6.5 mm) crochet hook or

size needed to obtain gauge **Notions:** Tapestry needle

### **GAUGE**

1.5 fans x 4 rows = 4" in Open Fan Stitch Save time, check your gauge.

#### STITCH GUIDE

**Open Fan Stitch** (multiples of 6+3)

**Row 1:** Dc in 3<sup>rd</sup> ch from hk, sk 3 ch, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same ch, \*sk 5 ch, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch\*; rep from \* until 4 chs remain, sk 3, dc in last ch. Turn.

Row 2: Ch 2, dc in first st, \*(3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp\*; rep from \* to end, working one dc in the last dc of the row.

Rep Row 2 for patt.

## **COWL**

Ch 23.

Work **Open Fan Stitch** until piece measures

approximately 60" long.

Finishing Row: Ch 1, sc in each st and ch sp

across.

Fasten off, leaving an 8" tail for seaming.

# **FINISHING**

With tapestry needle, seam the short ends of the cowl together. Weave in ends.

**ch** chain

dc double crochet

hk hookpatt patternrep repeat(ing)sc single crochet

sk skip
sp space
st(s) stitch(es)
