



Aquatic Blanket

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 42½"

Length: 51"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Premier Basix Chenille Brights (100% Polyester; 5.3 oz/150g, 112yds/103m)

- 2126-28 Caribbean – 12 balls

Hook: US Size M/N-13 (9 mm) straight or *size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

8 sts x 4 rows = 4" in pattern

Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

Post Stitch Diamonds (*odd number of sts, add 2 for beg ch*)

Setup Row (RS): Dc in fourth ch from hook and each ch across, turn.

Row 1 (WS): Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 2: Ch 3 (does not count as a st here and throughout), *dc in next sc, fpdc in next dc from 2 rows below; rep from * to last sc, dc in last sc, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 4: Ch 3, dc in first 2 sc, *fpdc in next dc from 2 rows below, dc in next sc; rep from * to last sc, dc in last sc, turn.

Rep Rows 1-4 for patt.

Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Single, double crochet, and post stitches.

PATTERN NOTES

This Blanket is worked flat in rows following a four row repeat. Wrong side rows are always single crochet, while right side rows are double crochet and post stitches. By alternating placement of the post stitches, squishy, textured diamonds will appear right before your eyes!

BLANKET

Ch 87.

Work Setup Row of **Post Stitch Diamonds** –85 dc.

Rep Rows 1-4 of **Post Stitch Diamonds** until piece measures 51", ending with a WS row. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Block lightly.

Abbreviations

beg	beginning
ch	chain
dc	double crochet
fpdc	front post double crochet
patt	pattern
rep	repeat
RS	right side
sc	single crochet
st(s)	stitch(es)
WS	wrong side
