



## Hearthside Throw

### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Width:** 36"

**Length:** 38"

### MATERIALS

**Premier® Yarns Premier Basix® Chenille Max** (100% Polyester; 7oz/200g, 30yds/28m)

- 2071-04 Sand – 9 balls

**Needles:** US Size 50 (25mm) 32" circular needle *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** US Size 15 (10mm) double pointed knitting needle (used as cable needle), stitch makers or scrap yarn for use as stitch markers

### GAUGE

7 sts and 8 rows = 8" in Stockinette st

**Save time, check your gauge.**

### Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Knit and purl stitches.
- Twisted stitches.
- Cables.

### STITCH GUIDE

**Braided Cable** (*multiple of 11 sts + 2*)

**Row 1 and all WS rows:** K2, \*p9, k2; rep from \* to end.

**Row 2:** P2, \*3/3 LC, k3, p2; rep from \* to end.

**Rows 4 and 6:** P2, \*k9, p2; rep from \* to end.

**Row 8:** P2, \* k3, 3/3 RC, p2; rep from \* to end.

**Rows 10 and 12:** P2, \*k9, p2; rep from \* end.  
Rep Rows 1-12 for pattern.

**Right Twist (RT):** Knit next 2 sts together, leaving both on LH needle, knit first st again, remove both sts from LH needle.

**3/3 Right Cross (3/3 RC):** Slip 3 sts to cable needle and hold to back, knit next 3 sts, k3 from cable needle.

**Left Twist (LT):** Skip first st on LH needle, knit through the back loop of second st on LH needle, leaving st on needle, knit the first st, remove both sts from LH needle.

**3/3 Left Cross (3/3 LC):** Slip 3 sts to cable needle and hold to front, knit next 3 sts, k3 from cable needle.  
needle to RH needle.

### PATTERN NOTES

This Throw is worked flat, end to end. For stitch markers, use contrasting colored scrap yarn to make a ring that fits loosely around your knitting needle.

### THROW

With larger needle, cast on 41 sts.

**Row 1 (WS):** K1, p2, pm, work [Braided Cable pattern (beg at Row 1)] 3 times, pm, p2, k1.

**Row 2 (RS):** P1, RT, sm, work Row 2 of Braided Cable pattern to marker, sm, LT, p1.

Working RT and LT at each edge on RS rows, continue working in pattern until throw measures 38", ending on Row 6 or Row 12 of pattern.

Bind off in pattern.

### FINISHING

Weave in ends, using your fingers to push and pull the ends through the stitches.

### ABBREVIATIONS

<b>beg</b>	begin(ning)
<b>k</b>	knit
<b>LH</b>	Left Hand
<b>p</b>	purl
<b>pm</b>	place marker
<b>RH</b>	Right Hand
<b>RS</b>	Right Side
<b>rep</b>	repeat
<b>sm</b>	slip marker
<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)
<b>WS</b>	Wrong Side
