

Crochet Pencil Case

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 8¼" Height: 5"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Premier Basix® Chenille (100% Polyester; 10.5 oz/300g, 220yds/201m)

• 2055-16 Orchid – 1 ball

OR

Premier® Yarns Premier Basix® Chenille Brights (100% Polyester; 5.3oz/150g, 112yds/103m)

Any color – 1 ball

Hook: US Size J-10 (6 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, 1½" diameter button

GAUGE

7 sts x 7 rows = 4" in Single Crochet **Save time, check your gauge.**

Skills/ techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain stitches.
- Seaming.
- Sewing buttons.
- Single crochet stitches.

FRONT PANEL

Chain 23.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn - 22 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn. Rep Row 2 until piece measures 5". Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

BACK PANEL

Work same as Front Panel until piece measures 7".
Fasten off.

BUTTON LOOP

Attach yarn to center of Back Panel. Chain 10 sts, attach on other side. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Place the Front Panel on top of the Back Panel, lining up the foundation ch edges. Thread yarn tail from Front Panel into yarn needle. Sew side and buttom seams.

Fold the Button Loop in half and sew center of fasten off edge to Back Panel.

Sew button to center of Front Panel, approximately 2" down from top edge.

Weave in all ends.
