



## High and Low Blanket

### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Width:** 36"  
**Length:** 47"

### MATERIALS

**Premier® Yarns Premier Basix® Chenille** (100% polyester; 10.5oz/300g, 220yds/201m)

- 2055-10 Sage – 4 balls

**OR**

**Premier® Yarns Premier Basix® Chenille Brights** (100% Polyester; 5.3oz/150g, 112yds/103m)

- Any color – 8 balls

**Hook:** US Size M-13 (9 mm) *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, 4½" cardboard strip (for making tassels)

### GAUGE

7 sts x 6 rows = 4" in pattern

**Save time, check your gauge.**

### Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain, single, double crochet and treble crochet stitches.
- Making tassels.

### BLANKET

Ch 65.

**Row 1 (RS):** Dc in 4<sup>th</sup> ch from hk and in each ch across, turn – 63 dc.

**Row 2:** Ch 1 (does not count as a st), sc in each st across, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in each st across, turn.

**Rows 4-5:** Rep Rows 2-3.

**Row 6:** Ch 4 (counts as tr), tr in each st across, turn.

**Rows 7-8:** Ch 3, dc in each st across, turn.

**Row 9:** Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

**Row 10:** Ch 4, tr in each st across, turn.

**Row 11:** Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

**Rows 12-13:** Ch 3, dc in each st across, turn.

**Rows 14-90:** Rep Rows 7-13, eleven more times.

**Row 91:** Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

**Row 92:** Ch 4, tr in each st across, turn.

**Row 93:** Ch 3, dc in each st across, turn.

**Row 94:** Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

**Rows 95-96:** Rep Rows 93-94.

**Row 97:** Ch 3, dc in each st across.

Fasten off.

### FINISHING

Weave in ends.

### Tassels (make 4)

Cut a 48" piece of yarn and thread it in tapestry needle, set aside.

Wrap yarn around cardboard 20 times.

Insert threaded needle under all strands at upper edge of cardboard. Pull tightly and knot securely near strands. Cut yarn loops at lower edge of cardboard.

Cut a 20" piece of yarn and wrap 1" below knot and secure.

Trim tassel ends evenly.

Thread tassel with long length and hang on each corner.

<b>ch</b>	chain
<b>dc</b>	double crochet
<b>hk</b>	hook
<b>rep</b>	repeat
<b>RS</b>	right side
<b>sc</b>	single crochet
<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)
<b>tr</b>	treble
