 Any color –14 balls
Hook: US L-11 (8 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.
Notions: Tapestry needle

# GAUGE

3 Rps x 5 rows = 4" in Raised Pineapple Pattern **Save time, check your gauge.** 

**PATTERN NOTES** Throw is worked flat end to end.

# STITCH GUIDE

**Raised Pineapple Stitch (Rps):** Insert hook in designated st, yo, pull up a loop, [yo, insert hook in same st 2 rows below, yo, pull up a loop, yo, pull through first 2 loops on hook] 6 times, yo, pull through all 8 loops on hook (1 **Rps** made). **Raised Pineapple Pattern** (Multiple of 4 + 3 sts) **Row 1:** Sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, sc in each ch across, turn.

**Rows 2-3:** Ch 1(counts as a st here and throughout), sc in each sc across, working final sc in top of turning ch, turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 1, sc in next 2 sc, **\*Rps** in next sc, sc in next 3 sc; rep from **\*** across, working final sc in turning ch-1, turn.

Rows 5-7: Rep Row 2.

Row 8: Ch 1, sk first sc, \*Rps in next sc, sc in next 3 sc; rep from \* to last sc, Rps in last sc, sc in turning ch-1, turn. Row 9: Rep Row 2. Rows 10-13: Rep Rows 2-5. Rep Rows 2-13 for patt.

# THROW

Ch 107. Work in **Raised Pineapple Pattern** until piece measures 39".

# Border

Work 4 rows of single crochet around the entire piece (working 3 sc in each corner sp). Fasten off.
