



Don't Be Biased Scarf

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 9"

Length: 115"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Premier Basix™ Chunky (100% Acrylic; 3.5 oz/100g, 117yds/107m)

- MC: 1145-04 Antique White – 5 balls
- CC1: 1145-17 Plum – 2 balls
- CC2: 1145-06 Mustard – 2 balls

Needle: US Size 10 (6 mm) straight or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, removable stitch marker

GAUGE

14 sts x 26 rows = 4" in Garter st

Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

Bias Garter Stitch (*any number of sts*)

Row 1 (RS): Sl 1 pwise wyif, k2tog, knit to last 2 sts, kfb, k1.

Row 2 (WS): Sl 1 pwise wyif, knit to end.
Rep Rows 1-2 for patt.

Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Knit and slip stitches.
- Increases and decreases.
- Intarsia method of changing colors.

PATTERN NOTES

This Scarf is worked on the bias in one piece. A decrease is worked at the beginning of each right side row, while an increase balances it out at the end of each right side row. Most color changes are achieved through the intarsia method. When changing colors mid row, bring the new color up and around the old

color, putting a single twist in the strands, and preventing any holes from forming in the work.

Cut both contrast colors after each stripe instance. Leave main color attached, except when new contrast color stripes are introduced at the beginning of rows. In these instances, cut main color and reintroduce when called for later in that row.

When counting rows, remember that each garter stitch "ridge" counts as two rows, and each slipped stitch along edges also counts as two rows.

SCARF

With CC1, cast on 50 sts.

Setup row (WS): Sl 1 pwise wyif, knit to end.

Rows 1-40: With CC1. Place removable marker on the RS of work after the first RS row to help keep track of RS.

Rows 41-60: With MC.

Row 61: With CC2, sl 1 pwise wyif, k2tog, k34, with MC, k11, kfb, k1.

Row 62: With MC, sl 1 pwise wyif, k13, with CC2, k36.

Row 63: With CC2, sl 1 pwise wyif, k2tog, k33, with MC, k12, kfb, k1.

WS Rows 64-68: With MC, work to color change, with CC2, work to end.

RS Rows 65-67: With CC2, work to color change, with MC, work to end.

Rows 69-76: With MC.

Row 77: With CC1, sl 1 pwise wyif, k2tog, k26, with MC, k19, kfb, k1.

WS Rows 78-84: With MC, work to color change, with CC1, work to end.

RS Rows 79-83: With CC1, work to color change, with MC, work to end.

Rows 85-128: With MC.

Row 129: With MC, sl 1 pwise wyif, k2tog, k26, with CC1, work to end.

WS Rows 130-136: With CC1, work to color change, with MC, work to end.

RS Rows 131-135: With MC, work to color change, with CC1, work to end.

Rows 137-144: With MC.

Row 145: With MC, sl 1 pwise wyif, k2tog, k18, with CC2, work to end.

WS Rows 146-160: With CC2, work to color change, with MC, work to end.

RS Rows 147-159: With MC, work to color change, with CC2, work to end.

Rows 161-168: With MC.

Row 169: With MC, sl 1 pwise wyif, k2tog, k6, with CC1, work to end.

WS Rows 170-176: With CC1, work to color change, with MC, work to end.

RS Rows 171-175: With MC, work to color change, with CC1, work to end.

Rows 176-248: With MC.

Row 249: With CC1, sl 1 pwise wyif, k2tog, k40, with MC, work to end.

WS Rows 250-264: With MC, work to color change, with CC1, work to end.

RS Rows 250-263: With CC1, work to color change, with MC, work to end.

Rows 265-272: With MC.

Row 273: With CC2, sl 1 pwise wyif, k2tog, k42, with MC, work to end.

WS Rows 274-280: With MC, work to color change, with CC2, work to end.

RS Rows 281-285: With CC2, work to color change, with MC, work to end.

Rows 286-292: With MC.

Row 293: With CC1, sl 1 pwise wyif, k2tog, k34, with MC, work to end.

WS Rows 294-310: With MC, work to color change, with CC1, work to end.

RS Rows 311-326: With CC1, work to color change, with MC, work to end.

Rows 327-352: With MC.

Row 353: With MC, sl 1 pwise wyif, k2tog, k10, with CC2, work to end.

WS Rows 354-368: With CC2, work to color change, with MC, work to end.

RS Rows 369-382: With MC, work to color change, with CC2, work to end.

Rows 383-436: With MC.

Row 437: With CC1, sl 1 pwise wyif, k2tog, k44, with MC, work to end.

WS Rows 438-444: With MC, work to color change, with CC1, work to end.

RS Rows 445-450: With CC1, work to color change, with MC, work to end.

Rows 451-458: With MC.

Rows 459-490: With CC2.

Bind off all sts.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Block lightly.

Abbreviations

CC	contrast color
dec'd	decreased
inc'd	increased
garter	knit every row
k2tog	knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)
kfb	knit into the front and back of the st (1 st inc'd)
MC	main color
patt	pattern
pwise	purlwise
RS	right side
sl	slip
st(s)	stitch(es)
WS	wrong side
wyif	with yarn held in front
