



Flat Hat & Mitts

Level: Easy

SIZE

One Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

HAT

Circumference: 20"

Height: 10½"

MITTS

Circumference: 6½"

Length: 7"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Premier Basix™ Chunky
(100% Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 117yds/107m)

- 1145-26 Faded Denim – 2 balls

Needle: US Size 13 (9 mm) straight needles
or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers,
extra-large pom-pom maker (optional)

GAUGE

10 sts x 20 rows = 4" in Garter st

Save time, check your gauge.

PATTERN NOTES

Both the Hat and Mitts are worked flat and then seamed.

HAT

Cast on 52 sts. Work even in Garter st until piece meas 7¾" from cast-on edge.

Crown Shaping

Setup Row: K1, (pm, k10) 5 times, pm, k1.

Dec Row: K1, (sm, knit to 2 sts bef m, k2tog) 5 times, sm, k1 – 5 sts dec'd.

Next Row: Knit.

Rep these 2 rows 4 more times –
20 sts dec'd, 22 sts rem.

Then work Dec Row 3 times –
15 sts dec'd, 7 sts rem.

Cut yarn leaving a long tail for seaming.

FINISHING

Thread tail onto tapestry needle and draw through remaining sts and then sew seam. If desired, make pom-pom and sew to top of Hat. Weave in ends.

MITTS (Make 2)

Cast on 18 sts, leaving a long tail for seaming later. Work even in Garter st until piece meas 7". Bind off all sts, leaving a long tail for seaming.

FINISHING

With long tail from cast-on, sew Mitt together 3" along cast-on/bind-off edges, leave a 1" opening for thumb and then with long tail from bind off sew rem 3". Weave in ends.

k2tog	knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)
m	marker
meas	measures
pm	place marker
rem	remain(ing)
rep	repeat(ing)
sm	slip marker
st(s)	stitch(es)
