



## Mug Cozy

Level: Easy

### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Length:** 10" (unbuttoned)

**Height:** 3"

### MATERIALS

**Premier® Yarns Premier Basix™ DK**  
(100% Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 306yds/280m)

- 1142-20 Orchid – 1 ball

**Needle:** US Size 6 (4 mm) straight needles *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, 2- $\frac{5}{8}$ " buttons, contrasting scrap yarn for embroidering (1142-45 Frost was used for the sample)

### GAUGE

22 sts x 28 rows = 4" in St st

**Save time, check your gauge.**

### PATTERN NOTES

This Mug Cozy is perfect for gifting or cozy-ing up your own warm beverage. It fits most mugs with a handle and is worked flat and buttons closed around the mug. The Cozy can be made adjustable by adding additional buttons. Optional embroidery adds a fun and festive touch.

### MUG COZY

Cast on 7 sts using long-tail cast-on.

#### Increase Section

**Rows 1-3:** Knit.

**Row 4 (RS):** K2, kfb, k1, kfb, k2 – 2 sts inc'd, 9 sts total.

**Row 5:** K3, purl to last 3 sts, k3.

**Row 6:** K3, kfb, knit to last 4 sts, kfb, k3 – 2 sts inc'd.

Rep the last 2 rows 3 more times – 6 sts inc'd, 17 sts total.

#### Main Body

**Row 1 (WS):** K3, purl to last 3 sts, k3.

**Row 2 (RS):** Knit.

Rep these 2 rows until piece meas 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " from cast on edge or desired length to fit mug, end having just worked a Row 1.

#### Decrease Section:

**Dec Row (RS):** K3, ssk, knit to last 5 sts, k2tog, k3 – 2 sts dec'd.

**Next Row (WS):** K3, purl to last 3 sts, k3. Rep the last 2 rows 3 more times – 6 sts dec'd, 9 sts rem.

**Dec Row (RS):** K2, ssk, k2, k2tog, k2 – 2 sts dec'd, 7 sts rem.

**Buttonhole Row (WS):** K3, yo, k2tog, k2.

**Next Row:** Knit.

Rep last row once more. Bind off all sts.

## FINISHING

### Buttons

Sew buttons to end, opposite buttonhole.  
Place them approximately 1" apart to make  
Cozy adjustable.

Weave in ends.

If desired, embroider "sparkles" on St st portion of  
Cozy with contrasting yarn. First, embroider a large  
"X" followed by a smaller "x" over the center, tie ends  
together inside piece.

### Abbreviations

**dec('d)** decrease(d)

**inc('d)** increase(d)

**k** knit

**kfb** knit into the front and back of the next st  
(1 st inc'd)

**k2tog** knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)

**meas** measures

**p** purl

**patt** pattern

**rep** repeat(ing)

**RS** right side

**ssk** slip slip knit (1 st dec'd)

**st(s)** stitch(es)

**St st** Stockinette stitch: knit on RS rows,  
purl on WS rows.

**WS** wrong side

**yo** yarn over
