

**SIZE**

Takeout Cup

**FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

**Circumference:** 7¼" bottom – 8¾" top

**Height:** 4"

**MATERIALS**

**Premier® Yarns Premier® Basix™ DK**  
(100% Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 306yds/280m)

- 1142-30 Navy – 1 ball

**Needle:** US Size 6 (4 mm) and US 5 (3.75 mm)  
set of dpns *size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, stitch markers,  
contrasting scrap yarn for embroidering  
(1142-45 Frost was used for the samples)

**GAUGE**

22 sts x 28 rows = 4" in St st with larger needle

**Save time, check your gauge.**

**STITCH GUIDE**

**2x2 Rib** (*multiple of 4 sts*)

**Rnd 1:** \*K2, p2; rep from \* to end.

Rep Rnd 1 for patt.

**PATTERN NOTES**

This Cup Cozy is perfect for gifting or cozying up your own warm beverage. It fits the standard to go cup from most coffee shops and smaller travel mugs. The Cozy is worked in the round from the bottom up. Optional embroidery adds a fun and festive touch.

**CUP COZY**

With smaller dpns, cast on 40 sts, pm and join for working in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. Work even in **2x2 Rib** for 4 rnds.

Switch to larger dpns, work 5 rnds even in St st.

**Inc Rnd 1:** \*K9, kfb; rep from \* to end – 4 sts inc'd, 44 sts total.

Work 9 rnds even in St st.

**Inc Rnd 2:** \*K10, kfb; rep from \* to end – 4 sts inc'd, 48 sts total.

Work 5 rnds even in St st.

Switch to smaller dpns, work 4 rnds even in **2x2 Rib**. Bind off all sts in rib.

**FINISHING**

Weave in ends. If desired, embroider "sparkles" on St st portion of Cozy with contrasting yarn.

First, embroider a large "X" followed by a smaller "x" over the center, tie ends together inside piece.

**Abbreviations**

**dpn(s)** double point needle(s)

**inc('d)** increase(d)

**k** knit

**kfb** knit into the front and back of the next st (1 st inc'd)

**meas** measures

**p** purl

**patt** pattern

**pm** place marker

**rep** repeat(ing)

**rnd(s)** round(s)

**st(s)** stitch(es)

**St st** Stockinette stitch: knit every rnd.
