

**SIZE**

One Size

**FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

**Hat Circumference:** 22"

**Scarf Length:** 64"

**MATERIALS**

**Premier® Yarns Premier® Basix™ DK**  
(100% Acrylic; 5oz/140g, 383yds/350m)

- 1142-28 Heritage Blue – 3 balls

**Needle:** US Size 6 (4 mm) straight needles or size needed to obtain gauge

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, cable needle, stitch holders, large faux fur pompom (optional)

**GAUGE**

22 sts x 30 rows = 4" in Cable Patt

**Save time, check your gauge.**

**PATTERN NOTES**

Scarf is worked flat from end to end. Hat is worked flat from the bottom up and then seamed.

**STITCH GUIDE**

**4/4LC:** Sl 4 sts onto cable needle, hold in front, k4, k4 from cable needle.

**RT:** Sl 1 st onto cable needle, hold in back, k1, k1 from cable needle.

**LT:** Sl 1 st onto cable needle, hold in front, k1, k1 from cable needle.

**Row 1 (RS):** \*P1, RT, p3, k8, p3, RT, p1; rep from \* to end.

**Row 2 (and all even rows):** \*K1, p2, k3, p8, k3, p2, k1; rep from \* to end.

**Row 3:** \*P1, LT, p3, 4/4LC, p3, LT, p1; rep from \* to end.

**Row 5:** \*P1, RT, p3, k8, p3, RT, p1; rep from \* to end.

**Row 7:** \*P1, LT, p3, k8, p3, LT, p1; rep from \* to end.

Rep Rows 1-8 for patt.

**Twist Patt (Multiple of 20 sts)**

**Row 1 (RS):** \*P1, RT, p3, [RT, p1] 2 times, RT, p3, RT, p1; rep from \* to end.

**Row 2 (and all even rows):** \*K1, p2, k3, [p2, k1] 2 times, p2, k3, p2, k1; rep from \* to end.

**Row 3:** \*P1, LT, p3, [LT, p1] 2 times, LT, p3, LT, p1; rep from \* to end.

Rep Rows 1-4 for patt.

**SCARF**

Cast on 44 sts.

**Border**

**Row 1:** K2, work Row 1 of **Twist Patt** to last 2 sts, k2.

**Row 2:** K2, work in **Cable Patt** to last 2 sts, k2. Rep Row 2, 6 more times.

**Main Body**

**Row 1:** K2, work Row 1 of **Cable Patt** to last 2 sts, k2.

**Row 2:** K2, work in **Cable Patt** to last 2 sts, k2. Rep Row 2 until Scarf measures 62" from cast-on edge, ending with Row 8 of patt.

## Border

**Row 1:** K2, work Row 1 of **Twist Patt** to last 2 sts, k2.

**Row 2:** K2, work in **Twist Patt** to last 2 sts, k2.

Rep Row 2, 6 more times.

Bind off all sts.

## HAT

**Earflap** (Make 2)

Cast on 2 sts.

**Row 1:** Kfb, kfb, k1 – 5 sts.

**Row 2:** Knit.

**Row 3:** Kfb, k to last 2 sts, kfb, k1 – 2 sts inc'd.

**Row 4:** Knit.

Rep Rows 3-4, 8 more times – 21 sts.

Cut yarn, place sts on holder.

## Brim

Cast on 6 sts, place 1 Earflap on left needle, knit across Earflap, cast on 28 sts, place 1 Earflap on left needle, knit across Earflap, cast on 6 sts – 82 sts.

**Rows 1-7:** Knit.

## Body of Hat

**Row 1 (RS):** P1, work Row 1 of **Cable Patt** to last st, p1.

**Row 2:** K1, work in patt to last st, k1.

Continue as established until you have worked Rows 1-8 of **Cable Patt**, 2 times.

## Shape Crown

**Row 1 (RS):** \*P2tog, RT, p1, p2tog, k8, p2tog, p1, RT; rep from \* to last 2 sts, p2tog – 69 sts.

**Row 2:** K1, \*p2, k2, p8, k2, p2, k1; rep from \* to end.

**Row 3:** \*P1, RT, p2tog, 4/4LC, p2tog, RT; rep from \* to last st, p1 – 61 sts.

**Row 4:** K1, \*p2, k1, p8, k1, p2, k1; rep from \* to end.

**Row 5:** \*K2tog, ssk, [k2tog] 5 times, \*\*k1; rep from \* to last 2 sts, ending last rep at \*\*, k2tog – 32 sts.

**Row 6:** \*P2tog; rep from \* to end – 16 sts.

Cut yarn leaving an 18" tail and thread onto tapestry needle, weave through remaining sts and cinch tight.

Use the remainder of the end to sew side seam.

## FINISHING

Weave in all ends. Optional: Attach faux fur pompom to top of Hat.

Cut 3, 24" lengths of yarn. Fold in half and attach to cast-on edge of Earflap. Braid ends, holding 2 strands together for each section of the braid. When you reach the last 3" tie in overhand knot. Rep for other Earflap.

## Abbreviations

<b>k</b>	knit
<b>k2tog</b>	knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)
<b>p</b>	purl
<b>p2tog</b>	purl 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)
<b>rep</b>	repeat(ing)
<b>RS</b>	right side
<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)
