



Crochet Motif Throw

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 33", before edging

Length: 44", before edging

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Premier Basix® Super Bulky
(100% Acrylic; 5.29 oz/150g, 98 yds/90m)

- C1: 2121-17 Mustard – 1 ball
- C2: 2121-14 Peacock – 3 balls
- C3: 2121-32 Lime – 3 balls
- C4: 2121-04 Gray – 3 balls

Hook: US Size N-15 (10 mm) *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

6½ sc x 8 rows = 4"

1 Motif = 12½" wide

Save time, check your gauge.

Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Single, double crochet, and cluster stitches.
- Working through the back loop.
- Seaming with mattress stitch.

STITCH GUIDE

Beg Cl: Ch 3, (yo, insert hook in st indicated and pull up a loop, yo and pull through 2 loops) 2 times, yo and pull through all loops.

Cl: (Yo, insert hook in st indicated and pull up a loop, yo and pull through 2 loops) 3 times, yo and pull through all loops.

Magic Ring: Wrap yarn around your left finger twice, leaving a 6" tail. Insert hook under both strands and pull up a loop. Ch 1, and beg working directly into center of ring. This ring

can be tightened later by pulling on the yarn tail.

Motif

Begin with C1 and **Magic Ring**.

Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc), 15 dc in ring, join with sl st to top of beg ch-3 using C2 – 16 dc. Fasten off C1.

Rnd 2: **Beg Cl** in same st, ch 1, *Cl, ch 1; rep from * around, join with sl st to top of **Beg Cl** using C3 – 16 cl, 16 ch-1 sps. Fasten off C2.

Rnd 3: Sl st in next sp, ch 3, dc3tog in same sp, ch 2, *dc4tog in same sp, ch 2; rep from * around, join with sl st to top of dc3tog using C4 – 16 dc4tog, 16 ch-2 sps. Fasten off C3.

Rnd 4: Sl st to ch-2 sp, ch 2 (counts as hdc), 2 hdc in same sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next sp, ch 1, *(3 tr, ch 2, 3 tr) in next sp (corner made), ch 1, 3 dc in next sp, ch 1, 3 hdc in next sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next sp, ch 1; rep from * 2 more times, *(3 tr, ch 2, 3 tr) in next sp (corner made), ch 1, 3 dc in next sp, ch 1, join with sl st to top of beg ch-2. Fasten off.

PATTERN NOTES

This Throw is worked in individual motifs that are sewn together. A border is added after seaming.

THROW

Make 12 **Motifs**. Sew **Motifs** together using mattress stitch in a 3x4 formation.

Border

Join C2 to any corner.

Rnd 1: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), (ch 2, hdc) in same st, hdc in each st and sp to next corner, *(hdc, ch 2, hdc) in corner, hdc in each st and sp to

next corner; rep from * 2 more times, join with sl st to top of beg ch-2.

Rnd 2: Sl st to ch-2 sp, ch 2 (counts as hdc), (ch 2, hdc) in same st, hdc in each st and sp to next corner, *(hdc, ch 2, hdc) in corner, hdc in each st and sp to next corner; rep from * 2 more times, join with sl st to top of beg ch-2 using C3. Fasten off C2.

Rnd 3: Sl st to ch-2 sp, ch 1, 3 sc in same sp, sc in blo of each st to next corner, *3 sc in ch-2 sp, sc in blo of each st to next corner; rep from * 2 more times, join with sl st to beg sc – 15 sts & 4 ch-1 sps each side. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

beg begin(ning)

C color

ch chain

dc double crochet

dc3tog double crochet the next 3 sts together (2 sts decreased)

dc4tog double crochet the next 4 sts together (3 sts decreased)

hdc half double crochet

rep repeat(ing)

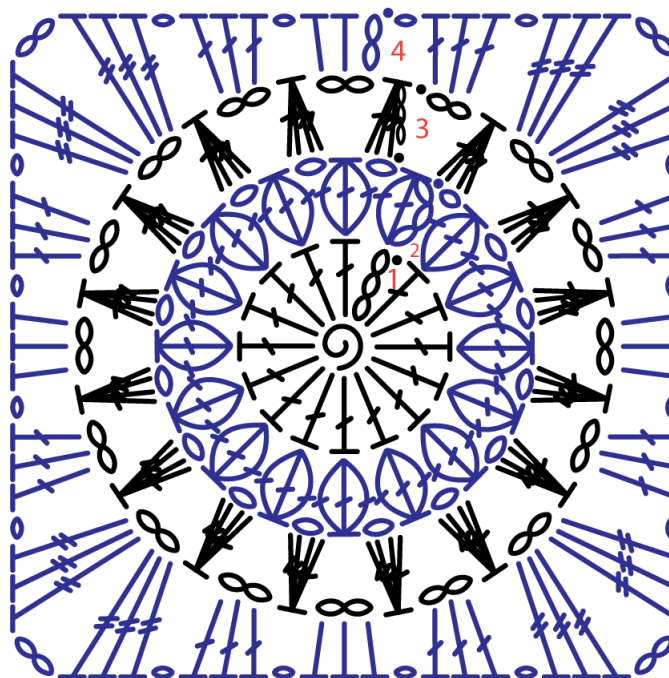
sc single crochet

sl st slip stitch

sp space

Motif Chart




