## One Size

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: $12^{\prime \prime}$
Length: 57" (not including Fringe)

## MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Premier Basix ${ }^{\circledR}$ Super Bulky (100\% Acrylic; 5.29 oz/150g, 98yds/90m)

- MC: 2121-19 Aran - 3 balls
- CC1: 2121-31 Sweet Potato - 1 ball
- CC2: 2121-17 Mustard - 1 ball
- CC3: 2121-11 Eggplant - 1 ball

Hook: US Size M/N-13 ( 9 mm ) and US Size L-11
$(8 \mathrm{~mm})$ or sizes needed to obtain gauge
Notions: Tapestry needle

## GAUGE

7 sc $\times 8$ rows $=4$ " with smaller hook Save time, check your gauge.

## Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain and single crochet stitches.
- Changing colors.
- Attaching fringe.


## STITCH GUIDE

Rick Rack Stripes (multiple of 5 sts +2 )
Row 1: Ch 1, sc in first $2 \mathrm{sc},{ }^{*} \mathrm{ch} 3$, sk 3 sc , sc in next 2 sc ; rep from * across.
Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first 2 sc, *ch 3, sk ch-3 sp, sc in next 2 sc; rep from * across.
Rep Row 2 for patt.

## PATTERN NOTES

Scarf is worked lengthwise. Cut colors at each color change. Leave an $8^{\prime \prime}$ tail when joining
and ending each color. Ends are incorporated into fringe. When changing colors, work up to the final step/pull-through of the last single crochet of the row, then complete the stitch with the new color.

## SCARF

With MC and smaller hook, ch 118.
Set-up row: Sc in second ch from hook and each ch across, turn - 117 sc.
Note: See pattern notes on how to change colors.
Switch to larger hook. Work Row 1 of Rick Rack

## Stripes.

Change to CC1. Work Row 2 of Rick Rack Stripes.
Change to MC. Work Row 2 of Rick Rack

## Stripes.

Change to CC2. Work Row 2 of Rick Rack Stripes.
Change to MC. Work Row 2 of Rick Rack

## Stripes.

Change to CC3. Work Row 2 of Rick Rack Stripes.
Change to MC. Work Row 2 of Rick Rack Stripes.
Rep the last 6 rows until piece measures approximately $12^{\prime \prime}$, ending with a MC row. Do not cut MC at the end of the final row.
Switch to smaller hook.
Next row: Ch 1 , sc in first $2 \mathrm{sc}, * 3$ sc in ch-3 sp, sc in next 2 sc ; rep from * across. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

For each stripe and for each end of scarf, cut 2 pieces of the corresponding yarn color that are 16 " long. Holding strands together as one, attach groups of fringe to the end of each

project continued
stripe. Trim fringe evenly to approximately $71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

ch(s) chain(s)
MC main color
rep repeat(ing)
sc single crochet
sk skip
sp space


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
