



SIZES

Women (Men)
Shown in Men's Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference (to fit): 21 (23)"
Length (with brim unfolded): 10 (12)"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Premier Basix® (100% Acrylic;
7oz/100g, 359yds/328m)

- 1115-37 Juniper – 1 ball for both sizes

Hook: US Size H-8 (5 mm) crochet hook *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

16 hdc x 8 rows = 4" in patt
Save time, check your gauge.

Skills/ techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain stitches
- Third loop half double crochet
- Back loop only half double crochet
- Slip stitches
- Seaming/sewing

PATTERN NOTES

This Hat is worked flat and then seamed.

HAT

Ch 40 (50).

Row 1: Hdc in 3rd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn – 38 (48) hdc.

Note: Rather than working into the stitch as you normally would, you will work into the 'third loop' of the half double crochet stitch for Row 2. The horizontal line at the back of the stitch is the third loop. Working into this loop creates a unique, ribbing effect.

Row 2 (WS): Ch 1 (does not count as a st here and throughout), hdc in 3rd loop of each hdc across, turn.

Row 3 (RS): Ch 1, hdc blo in each hdc across, turn.

Rep Rows 2-3 until piece measures 21 (23)".

FINISHING

Fold hat with RS together and sl st across, joining last row worked to first row, fasten off leaving a long tail.

Thread tail on tapestry needle and run needle under the end of each row at the top of the hat. Pull snug to gather and close top of hat. Fasten off.

Weave in ends.

blo back loop only
ch chain
hdc half double crochet
patt pattern
RS right side
sl st slip stitch
st(s) stitch(es)
WS wrong side
