



## Seeded Columns Hat

### SIZES

Baby (Child, Adult S, Adult M, Adult L)  
Shown in Child Size

### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Circumference:** 15 (17, 18¾, 20¾, 22½)''

**Height:** 7¼ (8¼, 9½, 10, 11)''

### MATERIALS

**Premier® Yarns Premier Basix®** (100% Acrylic;  
7 oz/200 g, 359yds/328m)

- 1115-19 Lilac – 1 ball

**Needle:** US Size 9 (5.5 mm) and US Size 7  
(4.5 mm) 16'' circular needle and set of dpns *or*  
*size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, stitch marker

### GAUGE

17 sts x 23 rows = 4'' in St st in the rnd with  
larger needle.

Save time, check your gauge.

### Skills/ techniques used in this pattern:

- Knit and purl stitches
- Knitting in the round
- Small circumference knitting on dpns
- K2tog and p2tog decreases

### STITCH GUIDE

**Seeded Columns** (*multiple of 8 sts*)

**Rnd 1:** \*K3, p2, k1, p2; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 2:** \*K3, p1, (k1, p1) twice; rep from \* to  
end.

Rep Rnds 1-2 for patt.

**3x1 Rib** (*multiple of 4 sts*)

**Rnd 1:** \*K3, p1; rep from \* to end.

Rep Rnd 1 for patt.

### PATTERN NOTES

Hat is worked from the bottom up in the round.

Hat is shown with Pixie Dust City Block Cowl  
and Ever Soft Sideways Stripe Mitts (both  
patterns available for free on Premier Yarns  
website).

### HAT

With smaller needle, cast on 64 (72, 80, 88,  
96) sts, pm and join to work in the rnd, being  
careful not to twist sts. Work even in **3x1 Rib**  
until piece meas 1¼ (1½, 2, 2, 2¼)'' from cast-  
on edge. Switch to larger needle and work  
even in **Seeded Columns** until piece meas 5¼  
(6¼, 7½, 8, 9)'' from cast-on edge or to desired  
height less 2''.

### Crown Shaping

*Note: Switch to dpns when the stitches no  
longer fit comfortably on circular needle.*

**Rnd 1:** \*K3, p2, k2tog, p1; rep from \* to end –  
8 (9, 10, 11, 12) sts dec'd, 56 (63, 70, 77, 84) sts  
rem.

**Rnd 2:** \*K3, p1, k1, p2; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 3:** \*K3, p2, p2tog; rep from \* to end –  
8 (9, 10, 11, 12) sts dec'd, 48 (54, 60, 66, 72) sts  
rem.

**Rnd 4:** \*K3, p1, k1, p1; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 5:** \*K3, p1, p2tog; rep from \* to end –  
8 (9, 10, 11, 12) sts dec'd, 40 (45, 50, 55, 60) sts  
rem.

**Rnd 6:** \*K3, p2; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 7:** \*K3, p2tog; rep from \* to end –  
8 (9, 10, 11, 12) sts dec'd, 32 (36, 40, 44, 48) sts  
rem.

**Rnd 8:** \*K3, p1; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 9:** \*K2, p2tog; rep from \* to end –

8 (9, 10, 11, 12) sts dec'd, 24 (27, 30, 33, 36) sts rem.

**Rnd 10:** \*K1, p2tog; rep from \* to end – 8 (9, 10, 11, 12) sts dec'd, 16 (18, 20, 22, 24) sts rem.

**Rnd 11:** \*K2tog; rep from \* to end – 8 (9, 10, 11, 12) sts dec'd, 8 (9, 10, 11, 12) sts rem.

Cut yarn leaving a long tail. Thread tail onto tapestry needle and draw through remaining sts.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.

k2tog	knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)
meas	measures
p	purl
p2tog	purl 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)

pm	place marker
rem	remain(ing)
rep	repeat(ing)
rnd(s)	round(s)
sl	slip
sm	slip marker
st(s)	stitch(es)
St st	Stockinette stitch: knit every rnd.
