

## Seeded Columns Hat

## SIZES

Baby (Child, Adult S, Adult M, Adult L)
Shown in Child Size

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 15 (17, 183/4, 203/4, 22 $1 / 2$ )"
Height: $71 / 4(81 / 4,91 ⁄ 2,10,11) "$

## MATERIALS

Premier ${ }^{\circledR}$ Yarns Premier Basix ${ }^{\circledR}$ (100\% Acrylic; 7 oz/200 g, 359yds/328m)

- 1115-19 Lilac - 1 ball

Needle: US Size 9 ( 5.5 mm ) and US Size 7
( 4.5 mm ) $16^{\prime \prime}$ circular needle and set of dpns or size needed to obtain gauge
Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch marker

## GAUGE

17 sts $\times 23$ rows $=4$ " in St st in the rnd with larger needle.
Save time, check your gauge.

## Skills/ techniques used in this pattern:

- Knit and purl stitches
- Kniting in the round
- Small circumference knitting on dpns
- K2tog and p2tog decreases


## STITCH GUIDE

Seeded Columns (multiple of 8 sts)
Rnd 1: *K3, p2, k1, p2; rep from * to end.
Rnd 2: *K3, p1, (k1, p1) twice; rep from * to end.
Rep Rnds 1-2 for patt.

3x1 Rib (multiple of 4 sts)
Rnd 1: *K3, p1; rep from * to end.
Rep Rnd 1 for patt.

## PATTERN NOTES

Hat is worked from the bottom up in the round. Hat is shown with Pixie Dust City Block Cow and Ever Soft Sideways Stripe Mitts (both patterns available for free on Premier Yarns website).

## HAT

With smaller needle, cast on $64(72,80,88$, 96) sts, pm and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. Work even in $3 \times 1$ Rib until piece meas $11 / 4(11 / 2,2,2,21 / 4)^{\prime \prime}$ from caston edge. Switch to larger needle and work even in Seeded Columns until piece meas $51 / 4$ ( $61 / 4,71 / 2,8,9$ )" from cast-on edge or to desired height less 2".

## Crown Shaping

Note: Switch to dpns when the stitches no longer fit comfortably on circular needle. Rnd 1: *K3, p2, k2tog, p1; rep from * to end $8(9,10,11,12)$ sts dec'd, $56(63,70,77,84)$ sts rem.
Rnd 2: *K3, p1, k1, p2; rep from * to end.
Rnd 3: *K3, p2, p2tog; rep from * to end $8(9,10,11,12)$ sts dec'd, $48(54,60,66,72)$ sts rem.
Rnd 4: *K3, p1, k1, p1; rep from * to end.
Rnd 5: *K3, p1, p2tog; rep from * to end $8(9,10,11,12)$ sts dec'd, $40(45,50,55,60)$ sts rem.
Rnd 6: *K3, p2; rep from * to end.
Rnd 7: *K3, p2tog; rep from * to end $8(9,10,11,12)$ sts dec'd, $32(36,40,44,48)$ sts rem.
Rnd 8: *K3, p1; rep from * to end.
project continued

Rnd 9: *K2, p2tog; rep from * to end $8(9,10,11,12)$ sts dec'd, $24(27,30,33,36)$ sts rem. Rnd 10: *K1, p2tog; rep from * to end - 8 ( $9,10,11$, $12)$ sts dec'd, $16(18,20,22,24)$ sts rem.
Rnd 11: *K2tog; rep from * to end - 8 ( $9,10,11,12$ ) sts dec'd, $8(9,10,11,12)$ sts rem.
Cut yarn leaving a long tail. Thread tail onto tapestry needle and draw through remaining sts.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.
