



## Seeded Columns Mittens

### SIZES

Child (Adult S, Adult M, Adult L)  
Shown in Child Size

### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Circumference:** 5¾ (6½, 7½, 8½)''

**Length:** 7½ (8¾, 9¾, 10)''

### MATERIALS

**Premier® Yarns Premier Basix® Worsted** (100% Acrylic; 7 oz/200 g, 359yds/328m)

- 1115-50 Peach – 1 ball for all sizes

**Needle:** US Size 9 (5.5 mm) and US Size 7 (4.5 mm) 16'' circular needle and set of dpns or size needed to obtain gauge

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, stitch markers (2-3 different colors), stitch holder or waste yarn, pom pom maker (optional)

### GAUGE

17 sts x 23 rows = 4'' in St st in the rnd with larger needle.

**Save time, check your gauge.**

### Skills/ techniques used in this pattern:

- Knit and purl stitches
- Knitting in the round
- Small circumference knitting on dpns
- M1, M1L and M1R increases
- Slip stitches
- Ssk and k2tog decreases

### STITCH GUIDE

**Seeded Columns** (multiple of 8 sts)

**Rnd 1:** \*K3, p2, k1, p2; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 2:** \*K3, p1, (k1, p1) twice; rep from \* to end.

Rep Rnds 1-2 for patt.

**3x1 Rib** (multiple of 4 sts)

**Rnd 1:** \*K3, p1; rep from \* to end.

Rep Rnd 1 for patt.

### PATTERN NOTES

Mittens are worked from the bottom up in the round. Mittens shown on next page with Sweet Roll Frostie Waffle Hat and Parfait Chunky Parallelogram Cowl (both patterns are available for free on Premier Yarns website).

### MITTENS

*Note: You may find it helpful to use different color markers to indicate the beg/end of rnd and the thumb gusset.*

### Both Mittens

#### Cuffs

With smaller dpns cast on 24 (28, 32, 36) sts, pm and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. Work even in **3x1 Rib** until piece meas 1½ (2, 2, 2)'' from cast-on edge or to desired length.

Switch to larger dpns.

### Right Mitten

**Setup Rnd 1:** Work even in **Seeded Columns**.

**Setup Rnd 2:** Work 14 (16, 18, 20) sts in patt, pm, m1 (thumb gusset), pm, work in patt to end.

### Left Mitten

**Setup Rnd 1:** Work even in **Seeded Columns**.

**Setup Rnd 2:** Work 10 (12, 14, 16) sts in patt, pm, m1 (thumb gusset), pm, work in patt to end.

## Both Mittens

Work one rnd even in patt.

**Inc Rnd:** Work in est'd patt to 1<sup>st</sup> thumb gusset marker, sm, M1L, knit to marker, M1R, sm, work in patt to end – 2 sts increased.

Work 2 rnds even in patt.

Rep last 3 rnds 4 (5, 6, 7) more times – 35 (41, 47, 53) sts.

**Gusset Separation Rnd:** Work in est'd patt to 1<sup>st</sup> thumb gusset marker, remove marker, sl next 11 (13, 15, 17) sts to holder for thumb, cast on 2 sts to bridge the gap, work in patt to end – 26 (30, 34, 38) sts.

**Next Rnd:** Work in patt to 1 st before cast on sts, ssk, k2tog, knit to end – 24 (28, 32, 36) sts. Work even in patt until piece meas 6½ (7½, 7¾, 8)'' from cast-on edge.

## Shape Top

*(Note: As the stitches are decreased maintain the stitch pattern as much as possible).*

**Rnd 1:** K1, ssk, work 6 (8, 10, 12) sts in patt, k2tog, k1, pm, k1, ssk, work in patt to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 – 20 (24, 28, 32) sts.

**Rnd 2:** Work even in patt.

**Rnd 3:** \*K1, ssk, work to 3 sts before marker, k2tog, k1; rep from \* once more – 4 sts dec'd.  
Rep last 2 rnds 0 (1, 2, 3) more time(s) – 16 (16, 16) sts. Rep Rnd 3, 2 more times – 8 sts.

Cut yarn leaving a long tail. Thread tail onto tapestry needle and draw through remaining sts.

## Thumb

Return 11 (13, 15, 17) held thumb sts to dpns and join yarn.

**Rnd 1:** Knit to end, pick up and knit 2 sts at cast on edge of thumb opening – 13 (15, 17, 19) sts.

**Rnd 2:** Knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, ssk last st of rnd with 1st st of next rnd – 11 (13, 15, 17) sts.

Work even in St st until thumb measures 1 (1½, 1¾, 2)''.

**Dec Rnd 1:** \*K1, k2tog; rep from \* to last 2 (1, 0, 2) sts, k2 (1, 0, 2) – 8 (9, 10, 12) sts.

**Dec Rnd 2:** \*K2tog; rep from \* to last 0 (1, 0, 0) st, k0 (1, 0, 0) – 4 (5, 5, 6) sts.

Cut yarn leaving a long tail. Thread tail onto tapestry needle and draw through remaining sts.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.

<b>dec('d)</b>	decrease(d)
<b>dpn(s)</b>	double point needle(s)
<b>est'd</b>	established
<b>inc('d)</b>	increase(d)
<b>k</b>	knit
<b>k2tog</b>	knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)
<b>m1</b>	make 1 (1 st inc'd)
<b>m1R</b>	make 1 stitch, right leaning
<b>m1L</b>	make 1 stitch, left leaning
<b>meas</b>	measures
<b>p</b>	purl
<b>p2tog</b>	purl 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)
<b>patt</b>	pattern
<b>pm</b>	place marker
<b>rep</b>	repeat(ing)
<b>rnd(s)</b>	round(s)
<b>sl</b>	slip
<b>sm</b>	slip marker
<b>ssk</b>	slip slip knit (1 st dec'd)
<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)
<b>St st</b>	Stockinette stitch: knit every rnd.
