

Mod Triangles Blanket

### **FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

Width: 36" Length: 36"

#### **MATERIALS**

**Premier® Yarns** *Premier Basix*® (100% Acrylic; 7oz/200g, 359yds/328m)

MC: 1115-15 Crepe – 3 balls
CC1: 1115-26 Azure – 1 ball
CC2: 1115-02 Light Gray – 1 ball
CC3: 1115-16 Blush – 1 ball
CC4: 1115-38 Mustard – 1 ball

**Needle:** US Size 9 (5.5 mm) straights *or size* needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle

#### **GAUGE**

14 sts x 28 rows = 4" in Garter st, each square will measure approx. 6"

Save time, check your gauge.

# Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Knit stitches.
- Picking up and knitting.
- Decreases.
- Seaming.

#### **PATTERN NOTES**

This Blanket is made up of modular Garter stitch squares. Each square is knit separately and then they are seamed together. This project is great for travel knitting as the squares are small and easy to transport!

## **BLANKET**

Square

**Triangle One** 

With MC, cast on 15 sts.

Row 1 (WS): Knit.

**Row 2 (RS):** Knit to last 2 sts, k2tog - 1 st

dec'd.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 until 1 st rem, break yarn and pull through rem st.

## **Triangle Two**

With MC and RS of Triangle One facing (with the cast on edge on the right and the dec edge on the bottom), pick up and knit 15 sts along the top edge.

Row 1 (WS): Knit.

Row 2 (RS): Knit to last 2 sts, k2tog - 1 st

dec'd.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 until 1 st rem, break yarn and pull through rem st.

# **Triangle Three**

With CC and RS of Triangle Two facing (with the picked-up edge on the right and the dec edge on the bottom), pick up and knit 15 sts along the top edge.

Row 1 (WS): Knit.

**Row 2 (RS):** Knit to last 2 sts, k2tog - 1 st dec'd.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 until 1 st rem, break yarn and pull through rem st.

# **Triangle Four**

With MC and RS of Triangle Three facing (with the picked-up edge on the right and the dec edge on the bottom), pick up and knit 15 sts along the top edge.

Row 1 (WS): Knit to last st, sl 1 kwise, pick up and k1 from cast on edge of Triangle One, psso.

Row 2 (RS): Knit to last 2 sts, k2tog - 1 st

Rep Rows 1 and 2 until 1 st rem, break yarn and

pull through rem st.

Make 9 squares with each CC, for a total of 36 squares.

#### **FINISHING**

Sew squares together using MC, using guide for color placement.

Weave in ends.

CC contrasting color dec('d) decrease(d)
Garter st kwise knitwise

MC knitwise main color

**psso** pass slipped stitch over

rem remain(ing)
rep repeat(ing)
RS right side
sl slip
st(s) stitch(es)
WS wrong side
