

**SIZES**

One Size

**FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

**Length:** 64"

**Width:** 36"

**MATERIALS**

**Premier® Yarns Premier® Basix™**  
(100% Acrylic; 7oz/100g, 359yds/328m)

- 1115-14 Burgundy – 4 skeins

**Needle:** US Size 9 (5.5 mm) 24" or longer circular needle *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, stitch holder or waste yarn, 26- ¼ - ½" buttons

**GAUGE**

17 sts x 23 rows = 4" in St st

**Save time, check your gauge.**

**STITCH GUIDE**

**Garner Rib** (*multiple of 6+3 sts*)

**Row 1 (RS):** Knit.

**Row 2 (WS):** \*K3, p3; rep from \* to last 3 sts, k3.

**Buttonhole Row (RS):** K1, yo, k2tog, knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, yo, k1.

Rep Rows 1-2 for patt, work Buttonhole Row as indicated in patt.

**PATTERN NOTES**

This Wrap is worked in one piece with the back worked as the first half then, the second half is split and each front is worked separately.

**WRAP****Back**

Cast on 153 sts and work 1" even in **Garner st**. Work 5" even in **Garner Rib**, end having just worked a WS row. Work Buttonhole Row, cont in **Garner Rib** working Buttonhole Row every 2¼" until piece meas approx. 20" and there are 6 buttonholes. Work even in **Garner Rib** until piece meas 32" from cast-on edge, end having just worked a WS row.

**Right Front**

**Split Row (RS):** K74, kfb, k1, place the next 77 sts on stitch holder or waste yarn — 77 sts.

**Row 1 (WS):** K5, \*p3, k3; rep from \* to end.

**Row 2 (RS):** Knit.

**Buttonhole Row (RS):** Knit to last 5 sts, k1, k2tog, yo, k2.

Work Rows 1-2 for patt and then work Buttonhole Row every 2¼", cont in patt until Right Front meas approx. 31" from Split Row and there are 14 buttonholes. Work 1" even in **Garner st**, bind off sts.

**Left Front**

With RS facing, place held sts on working needle.

**Row 1 (RS):** Knit.

**Row 2 (WS):** \*K3, p3; rep from \* to last 5 sts, k5.

Work Rows 1-2 for patt until Left Front meas 31", then work 1" even in **Garner st**. Bind off all sts.

## FINISHING

Sew buttons along the outside edges of the Fronts, opposite of buttonholes on Back edges, and then sew buttons along the inside edge of the Left Front opposite buttonholes on Right front inside edge. Weave in ends.

## Abbreviations

| <b>k2tog</b>     | knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)                         |
| <b>meas</b>      | measures   |

| <b>pm</b>        | place marker   |
| <b>rep</b>       | repeat(ing)  |
| <b>st(s)</b>     | stitch(es)   |
