Beret and Mittens Set

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Beret Band Circumference: 18"

Mitten Hand Circumference: 6½ (7½, 8½)"

Mitten Length: 6½ (7, 7¾)"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns *Everyday® Marl* (100% Anti-Pilling Acrylic; 100 gm/180 yds)

103-06 Black Marl –2 balls

Note: 1 ball will make either the beret or the pair of mittens; you'll need 2 balls for the set **Needles:** US Size 8 (5mm) circular needle 16" long and set of 4 double-pointed needles or size needed to obtain gauge.

Notions: Stitch marker, waste yarn, tapestry needle

GAUGE

18 sts x 24 rnds = 4" in Stockinette St Save time, check your gauge.

BERET

Cast on 80 sts. Place marker for beginning of rnd and join to work in the rnd. Knit 6 rnds.

Next 4 Rnds: * K1, p1; rep from * to end. Next Rnd – Increase Rnd: * K1, kfb; rep from * to end – 120 sts.

Work in Stockinette Stitch (knit every round) until piece measures 4" past Increase Rnd.

Shape crown

Note: Change to double pointed needles when the sitches no longer fit comfortably around the circular needle.

Rnd 1: * K9, s2kp, k8; rep from * to end – 108 sts.

Rnd 2 and all even numbered rnds: Knit. Rnd 3: * K8, s2kp, k7; rep from * to end – 96 sts. **Rnd 5:** * K7, s2kp, k6; rep from * to end – 84 sts.

Rnd 7: * K6, s2kp, k5; rep from * to end – 72 sts

Rnd 9: * K5, s2kp, k4; rep from * to end – 60 sts.

Rnd 11: * K4, s2kp, k3; rep from * to end – 48 sts.

Rnd 13: * K3, s2kp, k2; rep from * to end – 36 sts.

Rnd 15: * K2, s2kp, k1; rep from * to end – 24 sts.

Rnd 17: * K1, s2kp; rep from * to end – 12 sts.

Rnd 19: K2tog 6 times – 6 sts. **Rnd 20:** K2tog 3 times – 3 sts.

remaining 3 sts and pull tight.

Top knot

Transfer remaining 3 sts to a single double pointed needle. Work i-cord as follows:

* K3, DO NOT TURN, slide sts to other end of needle, bring working yarn across wrong side of sts and rep from * until cord is 2" long. Cut yarn, use tapestry needle to draw tail through

Weave in ends. Tie an overhand knot in i-cord for top knot. Block gently.

MITTENS

Cuff

Cast on 28 (32, 36) sts. Place marker (pm) and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts.

Rnd 1: * K2, p2; rep from * around. Rep Rnd 1 until Cuff measures 2".

Lower Hand

Knit 4 rnds.

Next Rnd: M1R, k2, M1L, pm, knit to end – 30 (34, 38) sts.

Knit 2 rnds.

Increase Rnd: M1R, knit to marker, M1L, slip marker, knit to end - 2 sts increased.

Repeat Increase Rnd every 3rd rnd, 3 more times -38 (42, 46) sts.

Knit 1 rnd.

Separate Thumb Stitches

Slip first 12 sts onto waste yarn for thumb, cast on 2 sts, knit to end of round - 28 (32, 36) sts.

Upper Hand

Knit every rnd until Upper Hand measures 3¼ (3½, 4)".

Next Rnd: Remove marker, k1, place marker for new beginning of rnd, k1, ssk, k10, k2tog, k1, pm, k1, ssk, k10, k2tog, k1 – 24 (28, 32) sts.

Knit 1 rnd.

Decrease Rnd: * K1, ssk, knit to 3 sts before marker, k2tog, k1; rep from * once more – 4 sts decreased. Repeat last 2 rnds 0 (1, 2) more times – 20 sts. Repeat Decrease Rnd once more - 16 sts. Divide remaining sts onto 2 double pointed needles,

using kitchener stitch, graft top of mitten closed.

Thumb

Place Thumb sts from waste yarn onto double pointed needles.

Pick up and knit 4 sts across gap from cast on sts, knit across sts from waste yarn – 16 sts. Place marker and

join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts.

Knit every rnd until Thumb measures 2 (21/4, 21/2)".

Next Rnd: * K2, k2tog; rep from * around – 12 sts. Knit 1 rnd.

Next Rnd: * K1, k2tog; rep from * around -8 sts. Cut yarn and thread through remaining sts. Pull snug to close end of Thumb.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

k knit

k2tog knit 2 sts together (1 st decreased)
kfb knit in front and back of same st – 1 st increased m1R make 1 stitch, right leaning (1 st increased)

m1L make 1 stitch, left leaning (1 st increased)

p purl

pm place marker
rep repeat(ing)
rnd(s)

s2kp slip 2 sts together as if to knit them together, knit next st, pass 2 slipped stitches over st just knit – 2

sts decreased

ssk slip slip knit (1 st decreased)

st(s) stitch(es)
