



Frida Headband

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Flower: 3½" in diameter

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Bloom® Chenille (100% Polyester; 3.5 oz/100g, 87yds/80m)

- C1: 2099-07 Begonia – 1 ball
- C2: 2099-08 Buttercup – 1 ball

Premier® Yarns Parfait® Chunky (100% Polyester; 3.5oz/100g, 131yds/120m)

- C3: 1150 – 13 Bright Pink – 1 ball

Hook: US Size K-10.5 (6.5 mm) *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle, headband, glue gun

GAUGE

10 dc x 5 rnds = 4"

Save time, check your gauge.

Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain, single, and double crochet stitches.
- Working in rounds and joining with slip stitches.
- Changing colors.
- Wrap yarn around headband and glue in place with glue gun.

STITCH GUIDE

Magic Ring: Wrap yarn around your left middle finger twice, leaving a 6" tail. Insert hook under both strands and pull up a loop. Ch 1 and beg working directly into center of ring. This ring can be tightened later by pulling on the yarn tail.

PATTERN NOTES

This Headband is made by wrapping and gluing yarn around a headband, then crocheting 3 flowers in alternating colors and attaching flowers to the yarn-wrapped headband.

HEADBAND

Flower (*make 3, alternating colors as shown in photo or as desired*)

With C1, leaving a long tail to attach, make a **Magic Ring**.

Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc throughout), 14 dc in the **Magic Ring**, join with a sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch-3 – 15 dc.

Rnd 2: Ch 3, dc in same st, 2 dc in each dc around, join with a sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch-3 – 30 dc.

Rnd 3: Rep Rnd 2, drop C1, pick up C2 – 60 dc.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, 2 sc in each dc around, join with a sl st to beg sc – 120 sc.

Fasten off, weave in all ends except for 2 long tails.

FINISHING

Gather the fabric together at the base of the flower, wrap long yarn tails tightly around gathered base and tie in a knot, pulling fabric in and creating folds to form flower, leave some length on tails to attach to headband. You can also use a tapestry needle and the long tails to weave yarn through base before tying to make a tighter gather.

Assembly

Gluing as you go, wind yarn around headband in a spiral from one end to the other. Using remaining lengths of long tails, tie each Flower around headband tightly and glue in place.
