

My Square Garden Throw

## **FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

Length: 32" Width: 32"

#### **MATERIALS**

**Premier® Yarns** *Bloom® Chenille* (100% Polyester; 3.5oz/100g, 87yds/80m)

• MC1: 2099-07 Begonia 1 ball

• MC2: 2099-08 Buttercup – 1 ball

• MC3: 2099-09 Tulip – 1 ball

• MC4: 2099-11 Dewdrop – 1 ball

Premier® Yarns Parfait® Chunky (100% Polyester; 3.5oz/100g, 131yds/120m)

• CC1: 1150-53 Lagoon - 1 ball

• CC2: 1150-12 Sunshine – 1 ball

• CC3: 1150-08 Bubblegum – 1 ball

• CC4: 1150-06 Mint - 1 ball

• CC5: 1150-13 Bright pink – 1 ball

• CC6: 1150-49 Key Lime - 1 ball

**Hook:** 7 mm *or size needed to obtain gauge* **Notions:** Tapestry needle

# **GAUGE**

Rnds 1-4 = 4" in pattern

Save time, check your gauge.

# Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain, single and double crochet stitches.
- Making a Magic Ring.
- Working in rounds, joining with slip stitches.
- Changing colors.
- Seaming squares together.

# STITCH GUIDE

Magic Ring: Wrap yarn around your left middle finger twice, leaving a 6" tail. Insert hook under

both strands and pull up a loop. Ch 1, and beg working directly into center of ring. This ring can be tightened later by pulling on the yarn tail.

#### **PATTERN NOTES**

This Throw is made by crocheting 4 separate Squares from the center out in turned rounds. The Squares are seamed together, and a Border is crocheted around the entire Throw. Join all rounds with a slip stitch when instructed.

#### **THROW**

Square (make 4, working to Rnd 14 in each MC) With MC1, make a Magic Ring

Rnd 1: Into the ring, work (sc, ch 1, sc, ch 2) 4 times, join to beg sc, turn – 4 sc, 4 ch-2 corner sps, 4 ch-1 sps.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, \*(sc, ch 2, sc) in next ch-2 corner sp, ch 1, sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from \* around, join to beg sc, turn.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, \*(sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) to next ch-2 corner sp, (sc, ch 2, sc), in next ch-2 corner sp, ch 1; rep from \* around, join to beg sc, turn.

Rnd 4: \*Ch 1, (sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1)\*\* to next ch-2 corner sp, (sc, ch 2, sc), in next ch-2 corner sp; rep from \* around, ending last rep at \*\*, join to beg sc, turn.

Rnds 5-14: Rep Rnd 4. Fasten off.

**Rnds 15-16:** With CC1, rep Rnd 4.

Rnd 17: With CC5, rep Rnd 4.

Rnd 18: With CC1, rep rnd 4. Fasten off.

Work the next 3 Squares MC2 (MC3, MC4) in established pattern using the following stripe sequence.

Rnds 15-16: With CC2 (CC3, CC4).

**Rnd 17:** With CC5.

Rnd 18: With CC2 (CC3, CC4).

## **FINISHING**

Using photo as a guide, sew Squares together with CC6.

# **Border**

Join CC6 in any ch-2 corner sp with a sl st.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, 3 sc in same sp, (sc in each sc and each ch-1 sp to next ch-2 corner sp, 3 sc in next ch-2 corner sp) 3 times, sc in each rem sc and ch-1 sp, join to beg sc. Fasten off CC6, join CC5.

**Rnd 2:** With CC5, sc in each sc around, working 3 sc in each corner, join to beg sc. Fasten off, weave in all ends.

ch chain
MC main color
rem remain(ing)
rep repeat

rnd(s) round(s)

sc single crochet

sp(s) space(es)
st(s) stitch(es)
sl st slip stitch
yo yarn over
