



Rainbow Blooms Blanket

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length: 37½”

Width: 36”

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Bloom® Chenille (100% Polyester; 3.5oz/100g, 87yds/80m)

- C1: 2099-02 Cherry Blossom — 1 ball
- C2: 2099-03 Marigold — 1 ball
- C3: 2099-01 Daffodil — 1 ball
- C4: 2099-05 Forget-Me-Not — 1 ball
- C5: 2099-04 Lilac — 1 ball

Needle: US Size 11 (8 mm) 24” or longer circular needle *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

10 sts x 14 rows = 4” in St st

Save time, check your gauge.

Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Knit and purl stitches.
- Changing colors.

PATTERN NOTES

This Blanket is worked flat from end to end with large stripes to create a rainbow of flowers.

BLANKET

With C1, cast on 90 sts.

Work 1½” even in Garter st.

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2 (WS): K5, purl to last 5 sts, k5.

Rep Rows 1-2 until piece meas 7½” from cast-on edge. Cut C1, join C2.

Work Rows 1-2 until stripe meas 7½”, cut C2, join C3.

Rep for C3 and C4. After joining C5, work Rows 1-2 until stripe meas 6”.

With C5, work 1½” even in Garter st. Loosely bind off all sts.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

C	color
Garter st	Knit every row.
k	knit
meas	measures
rep	repeat
RS	right side
st(s)	stitch(es)
St st	Stockinette stitch: knit on RS rows, purl on WS rows.
WS	wrong side
