

# Rosy Day Poncho

Level: Intermediate

## SIZES

4-6 yrs (8-10) yrs

#### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Neck circumference: 17½ (20¼)"

Length: 20¼ (23½)"

#### **MATERIALS**

Premier® Yarns Bloom™ Chunky (100% Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 109vds/100m)

• 1114-14 Tulip – 4 (5) balls

**Needle:** US Size 11 (8 mm) 16, 24 and 32" circular needles *or size needed to obtain gauge* **Notions:** Stitch markers, tapestry needle

#### GAUGE

11 sts x 15 rows = 4" in St st in the rnd Save time; check your gauge.

# **STITCH GUIDE**

**St st in the rnd (Stockinette stitch):** knit every rnd.

#### **PATTERN NOTES**

This poncho is worked in one piece from the top down. Start with the shortest circular needle, then switch to progressively longer needles as the number of stitches grows and the work begins to feel crowded.

#### **PONCHO**

On 16" circular needle, cast on 48 (56) sts, pm and join to work in the rnd careful not to twist sts.

Rnd 1: Knit. Rnd 2: Purl.

Rnds 3-6: Rep Rnds 1 and 2, 2 more times.

**Rnd 7:** \* K6 (7), pm; rep from \* to end –

8 markers placed.

Rnd 8: \* K1, m1, knit to 1 st before marker, m1,

k1; rep from \* to end – 16 sts increased.

Rnds 9-13: Knit.

Rep Rnds 8-13, 8 (10) more times –

192 (232) sts.

#### Ruffle

**Rnd 1:** \* K4, yo; rep from \* to end – 240 (290) sts.

Rnds 2 and 3: Knit.

**Rnd 4:** \* K5, yo; rep from \* to end -

288 (348) sts. **Rnds 5 and 6:** Knit.

**Rnd 7:** \* K6, yo; rep from \* to end –

336 (406) sts. **Rnds 8 and 9:** Knit.

Pnd 10: \* 1/7 you ron from 3

**Rnd 10:** \* K7, yo; rep from \* to end –

384 (464) sts.

**Rnds 11 and 12**: Knit.

**Rnd 13:** Purl. **Rnd 14:** Knit.

Rnd 15: Purl.

Bind off.
