FREE KNIT PATTERN

Wildflower Blanket



TYPE: Knit

DESIGNER: Tori Gurbisz for Premier Yarns

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:

Length: 32"

Width: 32"

GAUGE:

11 sts x 15 rnds = 4" in St st in the rnd

Save time, check your gauge.

MATERIALS:

[Premier® Yarns Bloom® Chunky \(100% Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 109yds/100m\)](#)

- 1114-10 Wildflower - 6 balls

NEEDLES & NOTIONS:

- 2-US Size 11 (8 mm) 32" or longer circulars and set of dpns *or size needed to obtain gauge*
- Tapestry needle
- Stitch markers

SKILLS/TECHNIQUES USED IN THIS PATTERN:

- Working in the round on both circular and double point needles.
- Knit and purl stitches.
- Yo increases.

PATTERN NOTES

This Blanket is worked from the center out in the round, beginning on double point needles and then switching to circular needles when it becomes too large to comfortably work on double point needles. Two circular needles are used to accommodate the large number of stitches as the Blanket increases in size.

BLANKET

With dpns, cast on 8 sts leaving at least a 6” tail, and distribute evenly over 4 ndls, join for working in the rnd careful not to twist sts.

SETUP

Rnd 1: *Yo, k1, yo, pm, k1, pm; rep from * to end — 8 sts inc'd, 16 sts total.

Rnd 2: Knit.

MAIN BODY

Rnd 1: *Yo, knit to m, yo, sm, k1, sm; rep from * to end — 8 sts inc'd.

Rnd 2: Knit.

Rep Rnds 1-2, 38 more times — 328 sts total.

EDGING

Rnd 1: *Yo, knit to m, yo, sm, k1, sm; rep from * to end — 8 sts inc'd.

Rnd 2: Purl.

Rep Rnds 1-2, 2 more times — 352 sts total.

Loosely bind off all sts.

FINISHING

Using tail from cast on, thread tail through cast on sts and pull tight to close.

Weave in ends.

Wash and block to finished measurements, if desired.
