PREMIER



Diagonal Crochet Blanket

SIZES

Small (Medium, Large) Shown in Small Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS 28" x 28" (36" x 36", 48" x 48")

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Bloom (100% Acrylic; 7 oz/200g, 656 yds/600 m)

• #1090-01 Sweet Pea, #1090-02 Peony, or #1090-07 Hummingbird – 2 (3, 5) balls Hook: US Size G (4 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge **Notions:** Tapestry needle

GAUGE

20 hdc x 14 rows = 4''Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

Puff St: Yo, insert hk into st and pull up lp, [yo, insert hk into same st, pull up lp] 3 times, yo, pull through all 9 lps on hk.

BLANKET

Ch 4.
Row 1 (RS): Hdc in 3 rd ch from hk, 2hdc in next
st, turn – 3 sts.
Increase Row: Ch 2 (does not count as hdc
here and throughout), working in blo, 2hdc in
same st, hdc to last st, 2hdc in last st, turn – 2
sts increased.
Repeat Increase row until piece measures
28" (36", 48") along each side edge.
Decrease Row: Ch 2, working in blo, hdc2tog,
hdc to last 2 hdc, hdc2tog – 2 sts decreased.
Pop Docroaco Pow until 2 cts rom

Rep Decrease Row until 3 sts rem.

Next Row: Ch 2, working in blo, hdc2tog, sl st in last st. Do not turn.

Edging

Ch 1, sc evenly around blanket working 3sc in each corner, ending with a multiple of 2 sts + 1 along each side edge + 1 corner st for each corner. Fasten off.

With RS facing, join yarn with sl st, 2 sts to the left of the corner st.

Rnd 1: Ch 3, Puff St in same st, ch 1, sk 1 sc, *[**Puff St** in next sc, ch 1, sk next sc] to corner st, (Puff St, ch 1, Puff St, ch 1, Puff St) in corner st, ch 1, sk 1 sc; rep from * around, join with sl st in top of first **Puff St**.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in same st, [sc in each ch-1 sp and Puff st] around, working 3 sc in each corner st, join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
