



Arrow Wrap

Level: Intermediate

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length: 65"

Width: 20"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Anti-Pilling™ Everyday® Bobbin™ (100% Anti-Pilling Acrylic; 9oz/255g, 543yds/498m)

- 1137-07 Cordial - 2 bobbins

Needle: US Size 8 (5 mm) straight needles
or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, locking stitch marker

GAUGE

18 sts x 36 rows = 4" in Garter st

Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

Arrow Stripe

Note: C1 = solid 1, C2 = marled, C3 = solid 2

Rows 1-8: C1.

Rows 9-16: C2.

Rows 17-24: C3.

Rep Rows 1-24 for patt.

CDD (Centered Double Decrease): Sl 2 sts together, k1, p2sso — 2 sts dec'd.

PATTERN NOTES

This Wrap is worked from one end to the other with increases at each edge and two decreases at the center to create the arrow shape. This pattern can be worked until you run out of yarn, just make sure you have enough to complete the current stripe and bind off (allow a length of yarn approximately 3-5 times the length of the row for bind off).

WRAP

With C1, cast on 91 sts. Work the following rows in **Arrow Stripe** patt:

Set Up Row (RS): K55, place locking m on next st, k35.

Row 1 (WS): Knit to marked st, p1, knit to end.

Rows 2 (RS): K1, kfb, knit to 1 st bef marked st, **CDD**, knit to last 2 sts, kfb, k1.

Rep Rows 1-2 in **Arrow Stripe** patt until piece meas 65" from cast-on edge or to desired length.

FINISHING

Wash and block to finished measurements, if desired. Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

bef	before
dec('d)	decrease(d)
Garter st	Knit every row.
inc('d)	increase(d)
k	knit
kfb	knit into the front and back of the next st (1 st inc'd)
meas	measures
patt	pattern
p2sso	pass 2 slipped sts over
m	marker
rep	repeat(ing)
RS	right side
sl	slip
st(s)	stitch(es)
WS	wrong side
