



Chunky Infinity Scarf

Level: Easy

SIZES

One Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 48"

Width: 10"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Anti-Pilling™ *Everyday® Bobbin™* (100% Anti-Pilling Acrylic; 9oz/255g, 543yds/498m)

- 1137-15 Goldenrod – 2 bobbins

Needle: US Size 11 (8 mm) straight needles *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

9 sts x 8 rows = 4" in **Fisherman's Rib** with three strands of yarn held together

Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

Fisherman's Rib (*even number of sts*)

Set Up Row: Purl.

Row 1: *P1, **k1b**; rep from * last 2 sts, p2.
Rep Row 1 for patt.

K1b (knit 1 below): Insert needle into st one row below the next st on the needle and knit, dropping st off needle.

PATTERN NOTES

The Infinity Scarf is worked flat in one piece, and then seamed. All three strands of yarn are held together throughout the pattern.

INFINITY SCARF

With yarn held triple, cast on 24 sts. Work even in **Fisherman's Rib** until piece meas 48" from cast on edge, or to desired length. Bind off all sts.

FINISHING

Sew ends of Infinity Scarf together. Weave in ends.
