

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 48" Length: 52"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Anti-Pilling Everyday®

Bobbin™ (100% Anti-Pilling Acrylic; 9oz/255g, 543yds/498m)

- 1137-15 Goldenrod 1 bobbin (A)
- 1137-10 Tulipwood 1 bobbin (B)
- 1137-13 Lime Green 1 bobbin (C)
- 1137-16 Peacock 1 bobbin (D)
- 1137-12 Terracotta 1 bobbin (E)
- 1137-31 Gray 1 bobbin (F)

Hook: US Size I-9 (5.5 mm) crochet hook *or size* needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

16 dc x 6 rows = 4" in Wide Chevrons Pattern **Save time, check your gauge.**

PATTERN NOTES

Each colorway used in this blanket is noted by a letter in the striping pattern. Within each bobbin the 3 colors are noted as light solid = 1, marled = 2, and dark solid = 3. For example, if the pattern says A1, that means the light solid color of colorway A.

STITCH GUIDE

Wide Chevrons (Multiples of 14 sts + 4 for foundation ch)

Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook (counts as first dc), *dc in next 5 chs, dc3tog, dc in next 5 ch, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch; rep from * ending last rep with 2 dc in last ch, (instead of dc, ch 1, dc), turn.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), dc flo in next dc, *dc flo in next 5 dc, dc3tog flo, dc flo in next 5 dc, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch-1 sp; rep from * ending last rep with 2 dc in 3rd ch of turning ch, turn.

Row 3: Ch 3, dc blo in next dc, *dc blo in next 5 dc, dc3tog blo, dc blo in next 5 dc, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch-1 sp; rep from * ending last rep with 2 dc in 3rd ch of turning ch, turn.

Rep Rows 2-3 for patt.

BLANKET

With A1, ch 172.

Work Rows 1-3 of **Wide Chevrons** patt. Continue working in **Wide Chevrons** patt in this Stripe Sequence:

- 2 more Rows A1 (light solid)
- 4 Rows A2 (marled)
- 4 Rows A3 (dark solid)
- 2 Rows F
- 4 Rows B1
- 4 Rows B2
- 4 Rows B3
- 2 Rows F
- 4 Rows C1
- 4 Rows C2
- 4 Rows C3

4 Rows D1

4 Rows D2

4 Rows D3

2 Rows F

4 Rows E1

4 Rows E2

5 Rows E3

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

blo back loop only

ch chain

dc double crochet

dc3tog double crochet the next 3 sts together

(2 sts dec'd)

patt pattern
rep repeat(ing)
sp space
st(s) stitch(es)
