

Tiny Stripes Cowl & Mitts

SIZES

One Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

COWL: 24" circumference, 12" height **MITTS:** 7" circumference and length

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Anti-Pilling™ Everyday®

Bobbin™ (100% Anti-Pilling Acrylic; 9oz/255g, 543yds/498m)

• 1137-17 Blue Moon – 1 bobbin

Needle: US Size 8 (5 mm) 16" circular needle and/or set of double point needles, US Size 7 (4.5 mm) 16" circular needle and/or set of double point needles or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers, stitch holders or waste yarn

GAUGE

18 sts x 24 rows = 4" in St st with larger needle **Save time, check your gauge.**

STITCH GUIDE

2X2 Rib (multiple of 4 sts)

Rnd 1: *K2, p2; rep from * to end. Rep Rnd 1 for patt.

Tiny Stripes (any number of sts)

Note: C1 = solid 1, C2 = marled, C3 = solid 2

Rnds 1-3: With C1, knit. Rnd 4: With C3, knit. Rnds 5-8: Rep Rnds 1-4. Rnds 9-11: With C1, knit. Rnd 12: With C2, knit. Rnds 13-16: Rep Rnds 9-12.

Work once for patt.

PATTERN NOTES

The Mitts are worked from the bottom up in the round. The Cowl is worked in a tube and the ends are then seamed together.

MITTS (Make 2)

With smaller set of dpns and C1, cast on 32 sts, pm and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. Work even in **2X2 Rib** until piece meas 2" from cast on edge. Switch to larger set of dpns and work even in **Tiny Stripes** patt until piece meas approx. 4" from cast on edge.

Thumbhole Rnd: With waste yarn, k7, sl 7 sts back to RHN and knit again with working yarn; cont in patt to end.

Cont in est'd patt, once **Tiny Stripes** patt is complete, work even in St st with C1 until piece meas 2" from Thumbhole Rnd, or to desired length.

Switch to smaller set of dpns and work even in **2X2 Rib** for 1", bind off in rib.

Thumb

Undo waste yarn and place the 13 live sts on 2 of the smaller dpns (7 sts on one and 6 sts on the other). Join C1 and pm to indicate beg/end of rnd. K7, pick up and knit 2 sts bet ndls, k6, pick up and knit 2 sts bet ndls — 17 sts.

Next Rnd: K2tog, k1, p2, work in **2X2 Rib** to end.

Work 4 rnds in **2X2 Rib**, then bind off all sts in rib.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

COWL

With larger needle and C1, cast on 108 sts, pm and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. Work even in **Tiny Stripes** patt and then work even in St st with C1 until piece meas approx. 24" from cast on edge or to desired height. Bind off all sts.

FINISHING

Seam cast-on edge to bind-off edge. Weave in ends.

dpn(s) double point needle(s)

k knit

k2tog knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)

meas measures

p purl
patt pattern
pm place marker
rem remain(ing)

rep remain(ing)
rnd(s) round(s)
RS right side
st(s) stitch(es)

St st Stockinette stitch: knit every rnd.

WS wrong side
