

Wavy Ripple Wrap

SIZES

One Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length: 76½" Width: 14"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Anti-Pilling™ Everyday®

Bobbin™ (100% Anti-Pilling Acrylic; 9oz/255g, 543yds/498m)

• 1137-16 Peacock – 2 bobbins

Hook: US Size I/9 (5.5 mm) crochet hook *or size*

needed to obtain gauge Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

12 sts x 10 rows = 4" in Wavy Ripple Stitch Save time, check your gauge.

PATTERN NOTES

This Wrap is worked horizontally to create a vertical ripple pattern.

Carry your yarn along the side while changing colors to avoid weaving in so many ends.

STITCH GUIDE

Wavy Ripple Stitch (multiples of 14 + 2 for foundation ch)

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next ch; *hdc in next 2 ch, dc in next 2 ch, tr in next 3 ch, dc in next 2 ch, hdc in next 2 ch**, sc in next 3 ch; rep from * across, ending last rep at **, sc in last 2 ch, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 4 (counts as tr here and throughout), sk first sc, tr in next sc, *dc in next 2 sc, hdc in next 2 sc, sc in next 3 sc, hdc in next 2 sc, dc in next 2 sc**, tr in next 3 sc, rep from * across, ending last rep at **, tr in last 2 sc, turn.

Row 4: Rep Row 2.

Row 5: Ch 1, sc in first sc, sc in next sc, *hdc in next 2 sc, dc in next 2 sc, tr in next 3 sc, dc in next 2 sc, hdc in next 2 sc, sc in next 3 sc, rep from * across, ending last rep at **, sc in last 2 sc, turn.

Rep Rows 2-5 for patt.

WRAP

Ch 268.

Work **Wavy Ripple Stitch** piece measures 14", changing colors every 2 rows (approximately 40 rows).

Note: You will change colors every 2 rows with the lightest color first, the marled second, and the darkest third.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Gently block to Finished Measurements, if desired.

sc single crochet

sk skip
sp space
st(s) stitch(es)
tr treble crochet
